Texas Department of State Health Services Procedures Shipping M. tuberculosis Isolates to DSHS Laboratory, Austin

- 1. Establish an account
 - Please complete the "Submitter ID Request Form" found on our web site at dshs.texas.gov/lab/mrs forms.shtm
 - Email form to labinfo@dshs.texas.gov or fax to 512-776-7533
 - Once an account has been established, a submitter account number will be assigned

- 2. Order test request forms
 - Customers with established accounts can obtain current G-MYCO submission forms via email by following the instructions at the DSHS Laboratory Services Section website:

- 3. Acceptable material for isolate submission include:
 - Samples (1.0-1.5 ml) of broth culture (e.g., MGIT)
 - Growth from solid medium culture (sesame seed size or more)
 - Suspensions of solid growth in saline or Middlebrook broth (1.0-1.5 ml)
 - Single piece of solid culture media (e.g., L-J slant, Middlebrook agar slant)
 - Single tube of liquid culture media (e.g., MGIT)

Note: Isolate must be positive for M. tuberculosis complex

- 4. Unacceptable Material for Isolate Submission include:
 - Clinical Specimens (e.g., sputum, pleural fluid)
 - Sediments from processed clinical specimens
 - Cultures on Petri Plates
 - Cultures not yet identified as M. tuberculosis complex
 - Contaminated or suspected mixed cultures
- 5. If shipping an aliquot of a culture, place a portion of acceptable material into a 2ml screw-cap vial with washer or o-ring (e.g., Corning No. 430659)
 - Label each vial or culture slant with two patient identifiers (e.g., patient name and date of birth)
 - Package in compliance with the Category A Infectious Substance protocol

- 6. Complete the required submission forms
 - Fill out the DSHS G-MYCO Specimen Submission Form completely, making sure that the patient identifiers on the tube match exactly the identifiers on the submission form
 - Make sure the date of collection field is completed or the specimen will be rejected
- 7. Ship cultures following the Category A Infectious Substance protocol to:
