

The Public Health System



Public health systems are commonly defined as “all public, private, and voluntary entities that contribute to the delivery of essential public health services within a jurisdiction.”

The Public Health System

- ❑ The public health system includes
 - Public health agencies at state and local levels
 - Healthcare providers
 - Public safety agencies
 - Human service and charity organizations
 - Education and youth development organizations
 - Recreation and arts-related organizations
 - Economic and philanthropic organizations
 - Environmental agencies and organizations


