WHAT IS TIAP-PLUS ?

The Texas HIV Medication Program (THMP) pays health insurance premiums for eligible uninsured Texans living with HIV through TIAP-PLUS.

WHAT COSTS WILL TIAP-PLUS COVER?

TIAP-PLUS covers costs associated with medication needs, including:

- **Health insurance premiums –**
A premium is the regular monthly payment you make to your health insurance company to keep your coverage active.
- **Medication copayments –**
A copayment is a fixed amount you pay for your prescription drugs when you have health insurance.
- **Medication deductibles –**
A deductible is the amount you pay out-of-pocket for prescription drugs before your insurance plan starts to cover costs.

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STEP 1

Make sure you are enrolled in THMP and a qualified Affordable Care Act (ACA) health plan.

STEP 2

- Complete the [My Health Information Checklist](#).
- Go to [Healthcare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) to apply for coverage, or
- Call your local agency.

STEP 3

If you have access to TakeChargeTexas (TCT), you can apply through the TCT online client portal. Visit [TakeChargeTexas](#).

STEP 4

On the dashboard, click the blue button on your screen to start.

STEP 5

Upload proof of income, Texas residency, and insurance.

STEP 6

Send the billing statement or invoice to dshsthmpaca@dshs.texas.gov and call THMP at 800-255-1090, option 4, option 1.

STEP 7

Welcome to TIAP-PLUS!
Use both your primary insurance card and Ramsell copay card at an in-network Ramsell-participating pharmacy.

When your enrollment is complete, THMP will mail you information explaining how you can use your benefits and a Ramsell prescription co-payment card.
