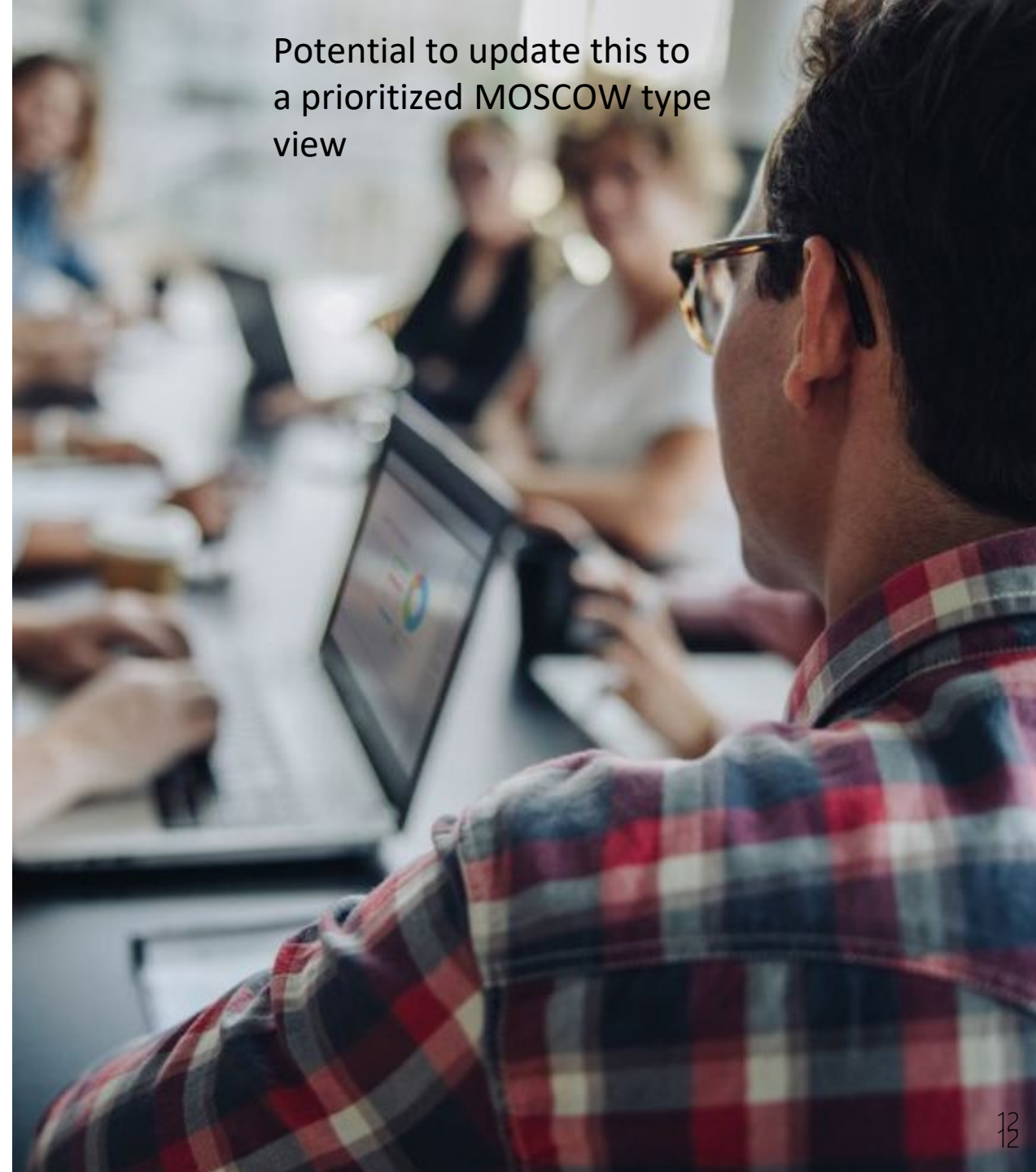

Feature Updates: Sprint 11

Document Start and End Date Enhancements

The Review Application screen of all application workflows (*in both Agency and Client Portal*), as well as the Application History pdf (*in Agency Portal*) will include the below new fields:

- Document Start Date, Document End Date

In the agency portal, on the ‘Multi-Provider Document Verification’ page screen, the following new columns will be available:

- Document Start Date, Document End Date, Verification Comments, Updated ‘Action’ Column to display Edit hyperlink providing Users the capability to edit the Document Start Date and Document End Date

TCT Users will be able to define a range of time that a client’s uploaded document is valid so that Proof of Income documents will be picked up by the FPL batch if they are considered valid during the RSR reporting period but were not uploaded until after the RSR reporting period.

Feature Updates: Sprint 11

Document Start and End Date Enhancements Continued

New banner is displayed when the 'Verified' check box is checked off by a User, with the below message: 'Select the 'Edit' button to provide verification comments before saving changes as verification comments cannot be updated after document verification'

When a user selects 'Edit', a pop-up appears in which only certain fields are editable, as noted below:

- Document Category (*non-editable*), File Name (*non-editable*), Date Added (*non-editable*), Document Start Date (*User editable*), Document End Date (*User editable*), Upload Comments (*non-editable*), Verified, Verified by (*non-editable*), Verification Comments

In addition, the FPL batch will follow has the following new logic:

- *A client's verified Proof of Income Document must have a 'Date Added' that falls within the RSR reporting period*

If the client's verified Proof of Income Document does not have a 'Date Added' that falls within the RSR reporting period, the date range defined by the Document Start Date and Document End Date must fall within the RSR reporting period.

TCT Users will be able to define a range of time that a client's uploaded document is valid so that Proof of Income documents will be picked up by the FPL batch if they are considered valid during the RSR reporting period but were not uploaded until after the RSR reporting period.

Feature Updates: Sprint 11

FPL: Overriding System Derived Household FPL for CARE Clients

TCT Users will now have access to FPL data shown in the 'Eligibility Calculated FPL' section and the 'System Derived FPL' section with the option to override the data.

On the CARE Service Referrals screen, a section titled 'Eligibility Calculated FPL' has been created to display Eligibility Period, Household FPL and Individual FPL values:

The 'Override' button in the Override column is only enabled for selection when the following conditions are met:

- The user overriding the System Derived Household FPL has one of the following roles: HRAR Admin, Data Manager
- The System Derived Household FPL Source must be 'Create Client Import' or 'User Override'
- The System Derived Household FPL being overridden is the most recent record in the System Derived FPLs table

When a user selects the 'Override System FPL' button, the following will occur:

- A pop-up, titled **Override System FPL**, will appear with the following information:

System Derived Household FPL, New System Derived Household FPL , Reason for Override

Upon entering the mandatory information on the 'Override System FPL' pop-up and saving the data, the following will occur:

- A new row will be created in the System Derived FPL table indicating the Update Date, System Derived Household FPL, Source, FPL Date, Updated By, and the Reason for Override
 - The new FPL value provided by the user will be reflected in the RSR report when an eligibility calculated FPL is not present for the RSR reporting period.

When a THMP Eligibility is conducted after the client has a value / record in the System Derived FPL table, the new THMP Eligibility FPL value will be reflected in the System Derived FPL table, as it will be the latest FPL value.

TCT Users will be able to override the System Derived Household FPL when the System Derived Household FPL Source is Create Client Import or User Override so that they can correct the data if it was incorrectly provided on the Create Client XML file and ensure the correct FPL value gets reflected on the RSR.

Feature Updates: Sprint 11

Enhancements to Comments Provided When Overriding or Ending Eligibility

TCT Users will have access to user comments on the 'Eligibility Summary' page, 'Eligibility History' page, and 'Client Eligibility Status Search Report' page.

- On the Eligibility Summary page screen, in the Current Eligibility Period table, the below new column is introduced: Immediate Denial
- Additionally, the 'Denial Reasons' column is updated to 'Eligibility Decision'.

On the Client Eligibility Status Search Report, the following updates have been made:

The 'THMP Reason' column will reflect the data that exists in the 'Eligibility Decision' column if the Eligibility Status is Approved, Rejected, or Denied

The 'CARE Reason' column will reflect the data that exists in the 'Eligibility Decision' column if the Eligibility Status is Approved, Rejected, or Denied

TCT users will be able to view user-entered comments when overriding or ending eligibility so that they can easily sort and filter the data that exists in the Client Eligibility Status Search Report.

Feature Updates: Sprint 11

Enhancements to Comments Provided When Overriding or Ending Eligibility Continued

When a User is undergoing the process of overriding the system-recommended eligibility decision, the following updates have been made:

- On the 'Eligibility Override' page, the Comments field box is updated to be an optional field for THMP Programs only
 - The Comments will remain mandatory for CARE programs.
- The Reject Reason, Pend Reason, or Denial Reason provided reflects in the 'Eligibility Decision' column on the Eligibility Summary page and no longer reflect in the 'Eligibility Status' column

When a User is on the Eligibility Summary screen, and chooses to End THMP Eligibility or End Care Eligibility, the following updates have been made:

- The Comments field box on the End THMP Eligibility pop-up, is updated to be an optional field for THMP Programs only.

For THMP programs only, the Denial Reason picklist has been updated to reflect the same reasons provided during the overriding Eligibility process.

Upon ending the eligibility period:

- A value of 'Yes' will display in the Immediate Denial column for the applicable program
- The Denial Reason provided will reflect in the 'Eligibility Decision' column
- If any comments were provided when ending the eligibility, the comments will display in the 'Override Comments' column and no longer be appended to the Denial Reason

TCT users will be able to view user-entered comments when overriding or ending eligibility so that they can easily sort and filter the data that exists in the Client Eligibility Status Search Report.

TCT Client Portal – Instructional Text Updates

TCT Users will now view additional instruction, in both English and Spanish, when logging into the Client Portal.

Begin by registering today if you are living with HIV and would like to apply or have already been receiving assistance for medications, medical care, or support services but do not already have a TakeChargeTexas account.

Log In if you already have a Take Charge Texas account.

You now have access to a new online system, Take Charge Texas (TCT).
You are encouraged to do the following:

- Contact your local agency or clinic to help you complete the application online through the Agency Portal.
- If you want and can create your own account, you may go to takechargetexas.gov and **register**.
- To be able to register, you must have an email address. You will be asked to create a user ID and a password.
- Once you have created your account, please contact your local agency or clinic who will then need to contact their Data Manager to Link the account you created with the account that already exists in TCT for you.
- Once the accounts have been linked, you will be able to log into the client portal and submit your application.

You do not need to register if you are interested in learning about HIV and STD's, testing and prevention resources like PrEP and nPEP. Go to the quick links at the bottom of this page.

Order Override Accessibility Enhancement

TCT Users will now have access to Order Override requests through a new report titled 'Order Overrides by Pharmacy Report'.

The following user roles will have access to the 'Client Regimen Overrides Report':

- HRAR_Admin, ADAP DataManAdmin, ADAP Order Processor, Pharmacist User

The following search criteria filters will be available for the User:

- Pharmacy, Pharmacists will only be able to view results for the Pharmacy they are associate with.
- Submitter First Name, Submitter Last Name, Client ID, Order Denial Reason, This multi-select, optional field will be a dropdown with the below options, Too early for a refill, Drug not in client's drug regimen, Client is not a part of ordering Pharmacy, Strength does not match drug regimen, Quantity has exceeded MaxPerMonth for Medication, Order Override Decision, Start Date, End Date

The following validation message will be displayed on the screen and will appear as a validation if the User clicks on Search without selecting any of the search criteria:

- Please select at least one search filter before proceeding

TCT Users will be able to view all the Order Overrides requested by any particular pharmacy in a given time duration, so that they can track this information and ensure process is efficient.

Removing Pre-Selected Services on Recert and Self-Attest Applications

When a User is completing a Self-Attestation or Re-certification application, the below logic will be applied on the My Needs page of the application workflow in both the agency and client portal:

- The User will now be able to de-select the pre-selected CARE and/or THMP services the client is currently enrolled in.
