Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) Provider,

Providers will not be able to order nirsevimab (Beyfortus[™]) in VAOS after Friday, March 22, 2024, at 5 p.m. CDT. Providers will be able to order Beyfortus[™] in VAOS later in 2024 when the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) make it available.

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends eligible infants be vaccinated with Beyfortus[™] by March 31, 2024. However, providers should not administer Beyfortus[™] after March 31, 2024, until the next RSV season in fall 2024. If providers have Beyfortus[™] doses which were not administered before March 31, 2024, and have not expired, they should keep doses at an appropriate refrigerated temperature for the following RSV season.
