

Flu Pre-book Reminder

To ensure flu vaccines are received before the start of the 2024 – 2025 flu season, TVFC providers should pre-book flu vaccine orders. The 2024-2025 TVFC Flu Pre-Book survey closed on Friday, February 2, 2024, but TVFC providers may still order flu vaccine by contacting both their Responsible Entity (RE) and TXVaccineOrders@dshs.texas.gov to submit a pre-book request.

Requests to pre-book flu vaccine should include:

- Presentation
- Quantity (in multiples of 10) for 2024-2025 flu season

Note: flu vaccines, Fluzone and Flulaval are the only available pre-filled syringe flu presentation to pre-book.

In Texas, flu activity typically reaches its highest point during February and lasts until May. It's crucial to continue vaccinating patients with the current 2023 2024 flu vaccines. Each season, flu vaccines are updated to closely align with the prevalent virus strains. TVFC providers must have flu vaccines available during flu season (October to June).

Update on Pfizer 6m-4y COVID Diluent

The diluent pack size of the 2023-2024, Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for people six months through 4 years of age [National Drug Code (NDC): 59267-4315-02] changed on February 29, 2024.

The pack size changed from a 10-pack diluent to a 25-pack diluent. Please note, one diluent vial is required to reconstitute one multidose vaccine for people six months through 4 years of age.

The following table shows the number of diluent vials providers will receive based on order size. Providers should dispose of unused diluent.

Total Doses of Vaccine	Total Vials of Vaccine	Diluent Supplied	Number of Diluent Vials to be Shipped
30 doses	10	1 pack of 25 vials	25
60 doses	20	1 pack of 25 vials	25
90 doses	30	2 pack of 25 vials	50
120 doses	40	2 pack of 25 vials	50
