Last Day to Order Influenza Vaccine

Friday, May 23rd will be the last day to order influenza vaccine in the Vaccine Allocation and Ordering System (VAOS) for the current 2024-2025 flu season.

Influenza vaccines will not be available to order in the TVFC Program again until the Fall of 2025.

Back-to-school MSLs

MSLs are calculated to provide a 75-day supply based on doses administered over the last 12 months. To determine appropriate MSLs for the back-to-school season, calculations use the same rolling 12-month period to calculate a higher 75-day inventory. MSLs will be calculated in this format from June to September to prepare providers for the back-to-school rush. See page 27 of the [TVFC/ASN Provider Manual](#) for more information.

Influenza Doses Expiring

Influenza doses for the 2024-2025 season expire on June 30th, 2025. Ensure that after this date, vaccine loss is reported for all remaining influenza inventory, with the loss reason as "Expired; did not notify HSR or LHD 90 days before expiration" or "Expired; notified HSR or LHD 90 days before expiration" in the Vaccine Allocation and Ordering System (VAOS). A return label will be sent to the Primary Vaccine Coordinator's e-mail address within seven days of reporting vaccine loss in VAOS for all expired doses eligible for return to the Central Distributor.
