

Important Updates on 2024 TVFC/ASN Program Re-enrollment Approvals, Data Loggers, and Suspensions

Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC)/Adult Safety Net (ASN) providers,

Providers must fully comply with TVFC/ASN program policies before January 1, 2024, to be approved for the 2024 program year. Providers must:

- Have data loggers with valid certificates of calibration
- Not have data loggers which expire after January 1, 2024
- Not have any program suspensions

Data logger expiration dates

The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) will not approve re-enrollment for a provider whose data logger certificates of calibration expire before January 1, 2024. Providers must have valid data loggers that expire after January 1, 2024. This ensures compliance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and DSHS policy for the 2024 program year.

Non-compliant providers

DSHS will not approve re-enrollments for suspended providers due to unresolved issues. This includes providers with:

- a VAOS hold due to TVFC/ASN non-reporting
- overdue non-compliant follow-ups in the Provider Education Assessment and Reporting (PEAR) tool
- non-compliance with data logger requirements
- Responsible Entity (RE) requested suspension

Re-enrollment approval for these non-compliant providers will be withheld until their non-compliance issues have been resolved.

All provider suspensions must be resolved by December 15, 2023; failure to do so will disqualify providers for re-enrollment in the 2024 program year. Providers not approved for re-enrollment will be suspended on January 1, 2024, and withdrawn on January 20, 2024.
