

# Adult Safety Net Program

## Become a Provider

The Adult Safety Net (ASN) Program provides adult vaccines at no cost for enrolled healthcare providers to administer to the public. The program was created by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Immunization Section to increase access to vaccination services in Texas for uninsured adults, thereby raising the immunization coverage levels and improving the health of Texans.



### Eligibility Requirements

Provider facility types that may enroll in the ASN Program include, but may not be limited to:

- DSHS Public Health Regions (PHR)
- Local Health Departments (LHD)
- Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)
- Rural Health Clinics (RHC)
- Federally Recognized Indian Tribes



### Enrollment Benefits

The ASN Program supplies publicly-purchased vaccine to enrolled providers to vaccinate uninsured adults who are 19 years or older. Additional benefits include:

- Improving vaccine access to uninsured adults
- Ability to bill a \$25 administration fee
- Training and education provided at no cost for your staff
- Access to a free automated vaccine ordering and reporting system
- Adults stay in their medical homes
- Adults receive vaccines on time
- Increasing immunization rates in your community
