

Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC)/Adult Safety Net (ASN) Program Providers,

The 2024 Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC)/Adult Safety Net (ASN) program re-enrollment opens October 2, 2023, and close on October 31, 2023. All updates to facility information, including patient population, must be submitted as a part of the 2024 TVFC/ASN program re-enrollment.

To begin the 2024 TVFC/ASN re-enrollment, access your account by logging on to the [HHS Enterprise Portal](#). Once logged in, select "Home" at the top left corner.

Next, select "Click to begin TVFC/ASN Enrollment" under the TVFC and ASN program section. Providers must complete each portion of the 2024 TVFC/ASN program re-enrollment as outlined by the headers.

The sections to be completed include:

#### TVFC/ASN Eligibility and Selection

- Confirm the facility type and if it is public or private. Note the TVFC-approved facility types have changed for 2024.
- Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Rural Health Clinics (RHCs) are required to upload a Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) letter verifying facility name, address and FQHC/RHC status.

#### Vaccines Offered

- Providers must select the appropriate vaccine category offering either all ACIP-recommended vaccines or select vaccines as a Specialty Provider.
- TVFC program providers must offer all ACIP-recommended vaccines unless they are a Specialty Provider.

#### Location and Shipping Address

- Providers must confirm their facility and shipping information is accurate. If needed, providers must update facility name, address, phone number and fax number.

#### Vaccine Coordinators

- Providers must confirm the primary and backup vaccine coordinators' names and titles, unique email addresses and phone numbers.
- The primary and backup vaccine coordinators must also submit all four of the required training certificates:

### Delivery Times

- Providers must confirm staff can accept vaccine shipments at least one weekday, other than Monday, for at least four consecutive hours between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

### Storage Capacity

- Providers must verify correctly documented data logger information:
  - Expiration date
  - Serial number
  - Calibration certificate

### Patient Profile

- Patient population data ensures vaccine orders are in the appropriate amounts and each site properly maintains its vaccine inventories.
- The patient profile captures the number of Federal and Texas VFC-eligible children served in each facility. Information reported on the patient-profile must represent the populations served during the most recent 12 months.
- The Federal VFC category includes:
  - Medicaid or Medicaid-eligible
  - Uninsured
  - American Indian/Alaska Native
  - Underinsured seen at FQHC/RHC/deputized PHR/LHD
- The TVFC category includes:
  - Underinsured seen at private clinics or non-deputized PHR/LHD
  - Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP)
- Underinsured is defined as a child with:

- Private health insurance that does not cover vaccines.
- Private health insurance that only covers selected vaccines.
- Private health insurance with a fixed dollar limit or cap for vaccines. Once the dollar amount is reached, a child is eligible.

### Prescribing Providers

- Providers must identify licensed health care providers with prescribing authority.

### Provider Agreement

- Providers must ensure the signing clinician is authorized to administer vaccines under state law and will be held accountable for the organization's compliance and all vaccinators at the facility.
- The signing clinician must sign and submit the Provider Agreement.

In addition to completing the 2024 TVFC/ASN program re-enrollment, providers must complete the 2023 Provider Satisfaction Survey. This survey gathers feedback to help improve the TVFC and ASN program(s). The Provider Satisfaction Survey will be open from October 2, 2023, and close October 31, 2023. TVFC/ASN providers failing to complete program re-enrollment will be suspended on December 29, 2023, and will be withdrawn from the TVFC/ASN programs on January 20, 2024.
