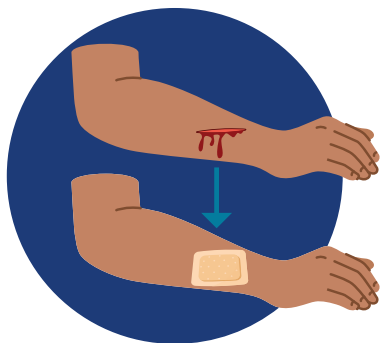


New World Screwworm



Prevent New World Screwworm

Preventing breaks in the skin and avoiding flies are key to protecting yourself or a pet from New World screwworm.

PROTECT YOUR SKIN AND PREVENT INSECT BITES.

Avoid New World Screwworm

- Keep cuts or wounds clean and covered as best you can.
- Wear long-sleeved shirts, pants, socks, underwear and hats.
- Wear bug spray, if possible.
- Get medical help for skin sores and wounds or skin conditions such as eczema or psoriasis.
- Sleep indoors, inside a tent, or under a mosquito net when possible.
- Check pets every day for wounds, including past tick bites. Watch for a bad smell, discharge, and larvae in or near the wound. Visit a vet immediately if you suspect New World screwworm.
