

TEXAS RADIATION ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

TOPIC RESEARCH COMMITTEE

Friday, April 21, 2023 8:30 a.m.

1. Call to Order

Darshan Sachde, Ph.D., Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. A quorum was present.

5. Routine and Continuing Business

A. High-Level Waste disposal

No update was provided.

B. Review of previous TRAB position statements

The committee discussed and reviewed these three advisory statements:

1) Advisory Statement for a Better Understanding of Radiation

Dr. Pate stated that the updates for this statement are straightforward. Mr. Hageman asked if we should include the first paragraph of the Advisory Statement on Sealed Source Disposal regarding what the TRAB is and does at the beginning of this Statement.

2) Advisory Statement on Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel in Texas

After reviewing TCEQ's comments, Dr. Pate stated that there is a question of if this statement needs to be maintained on our list of position statements as it has been determined by state law in past legislation that we are not allowed to store spent fuel in the state of Texas. It was decided to wait for recommendations from the INUW Committee.

3) Advisory Statement on Sealed Source Disposal

Some discussion was had regarding this Statement. Dr. Pate recommended that we wait for the recommendations from the INUW Committee.

Dr. Sachde asked that the committee members send their editorial comments on these statements to him so he can compile them and send them to Lisa Bruedigan at DSHS for review.

A. Licensed Medical Physicists Scope of Practice (Pate)

This presentation was deferred to the full TRAB meeting.

B. 2023 Strategic Plan Update (All)

Dr. Pate stated that the final draft was sent out that included the recommendations of all the groups.
