1. Call to Order

He asked if some guidance could be given to RSOs that could easily help them understand how the state classifies an industrial X-ray machine. Lisa Bruedigan gave some insight on this topic and suggested setting up an ad-hoc committee outside the TRAB to research this issue. Dr. Pate offered to serve as the Topic Research Committee and the Medical Committee representative. An INUW committee member would be identified in their meeting to provide help.
