
Immunization Updates




- Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)
 - On August 3, 2023, Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommended nirsevimab (Beyfortus™) for all infants aged <8 months who are born during or entering their first RSV season and for infants and children aged 8-19 months who are at increased risk for severe RSV disease and are entering their second RSV season.
 - Ordering opened on October 2 for TVFC providers
 - On October 13, nirsevimab ordering was paused by the CDC due to national supply constraints
 - Since October 30, ordering has been limited to brief 3-day windows every 2-3 weeks
 - Ordering timelines are dependent on when the CDC refreshes the state's allocations
 - Orders are reviewed by DSHS and apportioned based on need, inventory, and past administrations of similar patient populations

Total Nirsevimab Doses Distributed as of November 29 DSHS Border Counties vs Non-Border Counties








RSV, COVID, and Influenza Distribution, Border Counties October 2 through November 29
