## Influenza Immunization Data Update

### Influenza Immunizations

- Influenza immunization trends are monitored using data from the Texas Immunization Registry (ImmTrac2) and the Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) program through the Vaccine Allocation and Ordering System (VAOS).
- ImmTrac2 data includes doses reported to the registry for consented clients aged 6 months and older from July 1, 2024 to June 2, 2025.
- Please note: Data presented is specific to Texas Border Counties.
  - Border counties are defined as the 32 counties listed in the La Paz Agreement of 1983 (<a href="https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health">https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health</a>)

### **Border County Population**

- Coverage rates are vastly different when calculated using the counties population estimate versus the number of consented clients in ImmTrac2
- Population estimates were pulled from Texas Demographic Center (TDC). The 2023 estimates are the most recently published data.
  - Border counties are defined as the 32 counties listed in the La Paz Agreement of 1983 (<a href="https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health">https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health</a>)
- Number of consented clients was pulled from ImmTrac2 as of June 2, 2025



## **Annual Report of Immunization Status Data**

- The Annual Report of Immunization Status (ARIS) is completed by all publicschool districts and accredited private schools each year for kindergarten and seventh grade students.
- The purpose of this report is to monitor compliance with the Texas immunization requirements outlined in 25 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §97.61-97.72.
- Coverage is calculated by the total number of students up to date for a vaccine divided by the total enrollment for that grade.


## **Conscientious Exemptions**
