# Influenza Immunizations

- Influenza immunization trends are monitored using data from the Texas Immunization Registry (ImmTrac2) and the Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) program through the Vaccine Allocation and Ordering System (VAOS).
- ImmTrac2 data includes doses reported to the registry for consented clients aged 6 months and older from July 1, 2024 to June 2, 2025.
- Please note: Data presented is specific to Texas Border Counties.
  - Border counties are defined as the 32 counties listed in the La Paz Agreement of 1983 (<https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health>)

# Border County Population

- Coverage rates are vastly different when calculated using the counties population estimate versus the number of consented clients in ImmTrac2
- Population estimates were pulled from Texas Demographic Center (TDC). The 2023 estimates are the most recently published data.
  - Border counties are defined as the 32 counties listed in the La Paz Agreement of 1983 (<https://www.dshs.texas.gov/border-health>)
- Number of consented clients was pulled from ImmTrac2 as of June 2, 2025

Total Consented Clients in Border Counties per ImmTrac2	Total Population Estimate of Border Counties per TDC	Percent of Border County Population Consented in ImmTrac2
857,078	2,833,432	30.25%

- There was an increase of 7,214 in Consented Clients in ImmTrac2 since the February 2025 meeting.

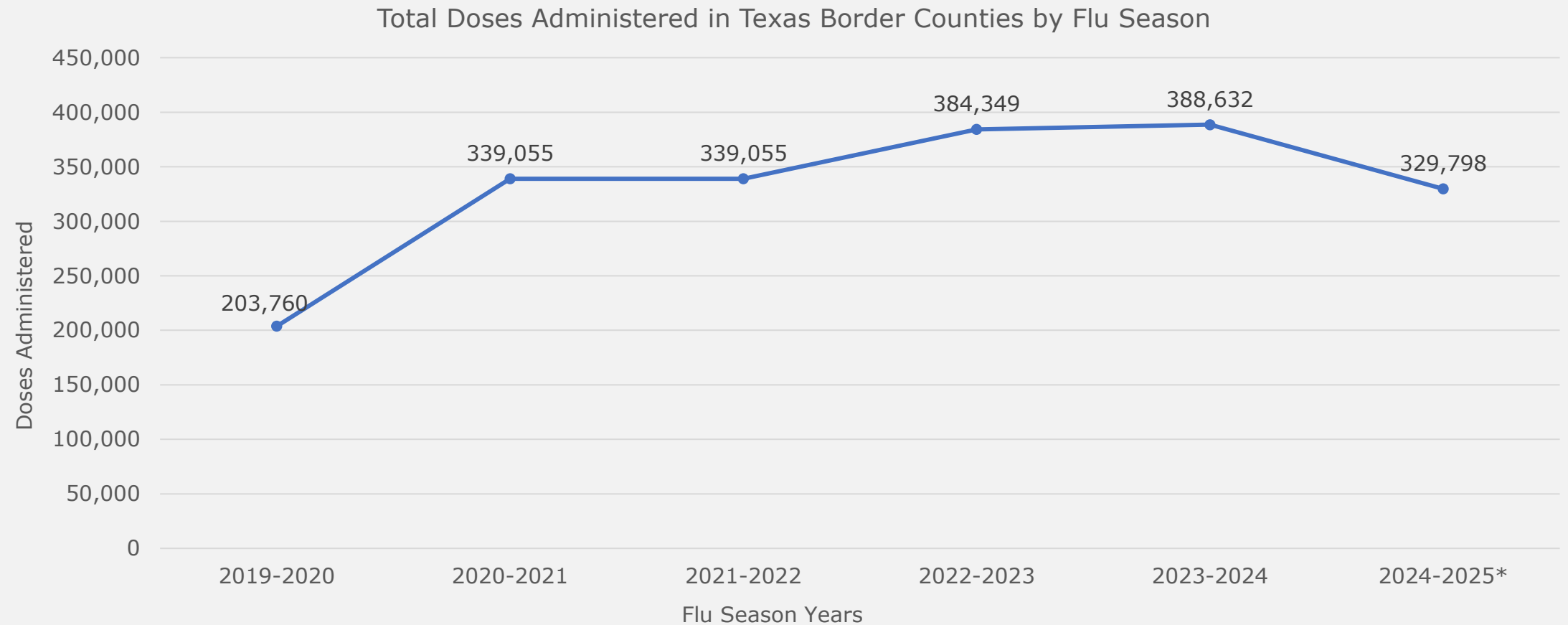

# Annual Report of Immunization Status Data

- The Annual Report of Immunization Status (ARIS) is completed by all public-school districts and accredited private schools each year for kindergarten and seventh grade students.
- The purpose of this report is to monitor compliance with the Texas immunization requirements outlined in 25 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §97.61-97.72.
- Coverage is calculated by the total number of students up to date for a vaccine divided by the total enrollment for that grade.

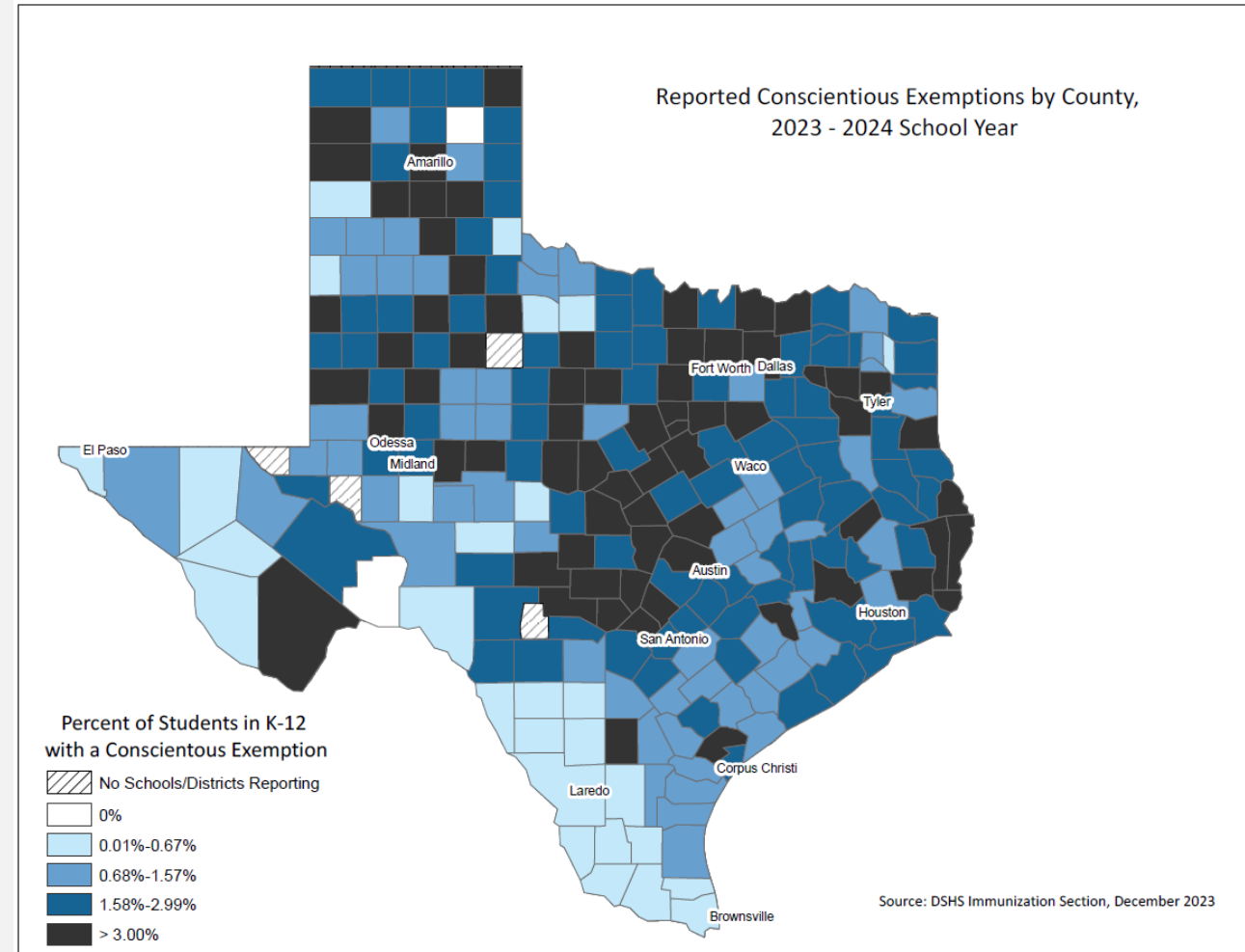
# Conscientious Exemptions
