Lack of capacity: financial, physical, as well as mental can be considered with verification Texas does not allow all people access to Medicaid, even in cases of extreme poverty, if no minor children are present in the home and they have not proven they are disabled. These people have no recourse to government provided healthcare and must rely on charitable health programs.
