The program is designed specifically for emergent/urgent and/or medically necessary care patients whose household financial resources and/or income are at or below 400 percent of the Federal Poverty Level. To qualify for any assistance, uninsured/underinsured patients will be asked to complete a CommonSpirit Health Financial Assistance Application(available in multiple languages) which includes information relating to household income and expenses. We are committed to working with our patients to establish an appropriate payment plan based on the amound due and the patient's financial status.
