
Trends, Distribution, and Demographics

Athletic Trainers

2019





In 2019, there were 3,482 actively licensed athletic trainers (ATs) in Texas.

- This number represented a 22.1% increase since 2014 and a 55.5% increase since 2009.
- Relative to population growth, the size of the athletic trainer workforce has improved by 24.5% over the past 10 years.
- Data were unavailable in 2000



Athletic trainers were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 4.0% difference between the number of athletic trainers in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas, the percent difference was 16.1%.
