

Hearing Instrument Fitters and Dispensers

2019





In 2019, there were 706 actively licensed hearing instrument fitters and dispensers (HIFDs) providing care in Texas.

- This number represented a 14.8% increase since 2014 and a 20.3% increase since 2009.
- Relative to population growth, the size of the HIFD workforce has improved by 2.4% over the past 10 years.



Within 10 years, 34.3% of the current Texas HIFD workforce will be eligible for retirement.

- 12.3% of active HIFDs in Texas were older than 65 years of age in 2019.
- 22.0% were between the ages of 56 and 65.

HIFDs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 30.2% difference between the number of HIFDs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas, the percent difference was 46.5%.
