

Pharmacy Technicians

2019




In 2019, there were 64,037 actively licensed pharmacy technicians in Texas.

- This number represented a 12.2% increase since 2014 and a 91.9% increase since 2009.
- Relative to population growth, the size of the pharmacy technician workforce has improved by 38.8% over the past 10 years.
- Data were unavailable for 2012.

Gender of Pharmacy Technicians

- In 2019, 75.2% of pharmacy technicians were female and 24.8% were male.
- Gender data were available for 63,369 pharmacy technicians.

Pharmacy technicians were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 26.2% difference between the number of pharmacy technicians in metropolitan and nonmetropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas, the difference was 13.5%.
