Audiologists Growth Trends


This fact sheet is an overview of the trends, distribution, and demographics of audiologists in Texas. In 2022, there were 1,383 actively licensed audiologists in Texas.


- This number represented a 17.1% increase since 2017 and a 33.2% increase since 2012 (Figure 1).
- The ratio of the Texas population per one audiologist in 2012 was 26,486:1 and in 2022 it was 22,175:1. The ratio has decreased by 12.0% over the past 10 years (Figure 2).¹

Figure 3. Ratio of Texas Population to Audiologist by County¹



Audiologists were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- The ratio of the population to audiologist was higher in non-metropolitan counties than metropolitan counties.
- The ratio of the population to audiologist was higher in border counties than non-border counties.
- 170 counties had no audiologists (Figure 3).

¹Population numbers are sourced from the Texas Demographic Center (previously the Texas State Data Center). The center regularly updates the demographic projections. Therefore, population numbers for a particular year may differ depending on the date the data was retrieved.

Demographics of Audiologists

Age

Within 10 years, 21.8% of the current Texas audiologist workforce will be over 65 years of age.

- Age data were available for 100% of licensed audiologists in 2022.
- 9.5% of active audiologists in Texas were over 65 years of age in 2022.

Gender

- In 2022, gender data was available for 32.8% of licensed audiologists. 85.7% of audiologists were female and 14.3% were male.
- In 2012, gender data was available for 55.9% of licensed audiologists. 84.3% were female and 15.7% were male.

Age Distribution by Gender

- Among audiologists over 55 years of age, males comprised 21.1% of the workforce.
- Among audiologists aged 40 years or under in 2022, 90.5% were female and 9.5% were male.
