- The Senate Bill 8 (SB 8) provides 21.7 million dollars for EMS Recruitment and Retention project has ended with the end of 2024. DSHS partner with Regional Advisory Councils (RAC) and EMS Education programs and EMS Providers to provide scholarships for candidates.

Texas EMS and Trauma Registries (EMSTR) extends our thanks to you for a record number of EMS data submissions during calendar year (CY) 2023 and 2024. For CY2025, the registry will continue collecting records in the National EMS Information System (NEMSIS) 3.5.0 format. There are no plans to implement the NEMSIS 3.5.1 or 3.5.2 minor revisions. Staff will begin to prepare for the NEMSIS 3.6.0 major revision in 2026. Beginning 02/01/2025, EMSTR will go through an annual network security audit. If an EMS Provider receive an email from EMSTR program, please promptly confirm the access privileges/rights for the staff currently assigned to the EMS Provider (agency) account.
