# Dental Pharmacological Considerations for Pregnant Women

## MAY BE USED

### Acetaminophen

 Acetaminophen with Codeine, Hydrocodone or Oxycodone

- Amoxicillin
- Cephalosporins
- Clindamycin
- <sup>o</sup> Metronidazole
- Penicillin
- Local Anesthetics with Epinephrine (e.g. Lidocaine)
- Chlorhexidine mouth rinse
- Professionally applied topical fluorides

Therapeutic Agents

Use alcohol-free products during pregnancy

# MAY BE USED WITH SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Second trimester, 13 up to 20 weeks: May use for short duration, 48 to 72 hours. Second trimester, 20 up to 27 weeks: Limit use.

- Aspirin
- Ibuprofen
- Naproxen

Consult with a prenatal provider before using:

Nitrous Oxide

## AVOID OR NEVER USE

Avoid use in the first and third trimester.

- Aspirin
- Ibuprofen
- Naproxen

### Avoid!

- Ciprofloxacin
- Clarithromycin
- Levofloxacin
- Moxifloxacin

#### **Never Use!**

Tetracycline

\*Oral pain can often be managed with non-opioid medication. If opioids are used, prescribe the lowest dose for the shortest duration (usually less than 3 days) and avoid issuing refills to reduce risk for dependency.
