EMS Policy 2025-A

Recognized EMS Instructor Acceptable Course

April 15, 2025

Background

The Texas Administrative Code allows for an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Instructor candidate to successfully complete a methods of teaching course or other type of instructor training course approved by the department as a method to gain EMS Instructor certification. The course completed shall be a minimum of 40 hours and all requirements shall be completed within one year of the completion date on the course certificate.
