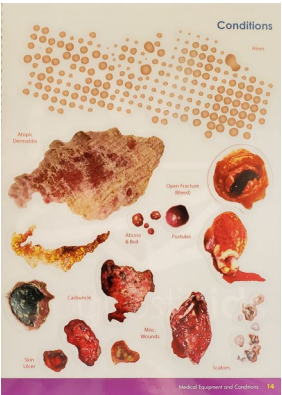
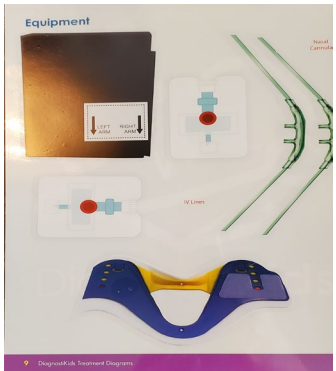
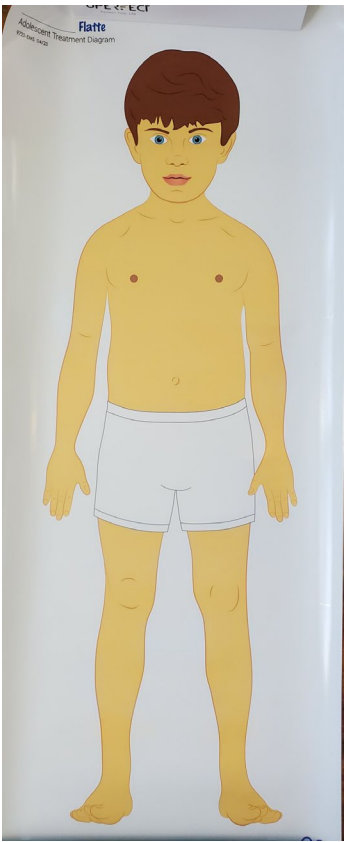
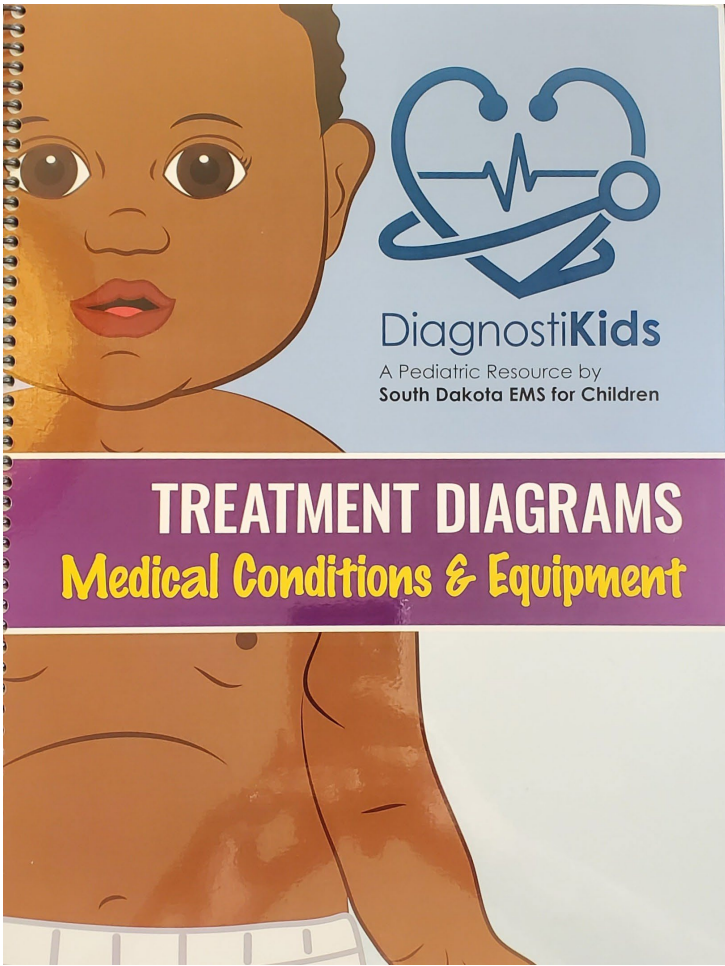


Phase 2 work by PRISMs with Hospital PECCs

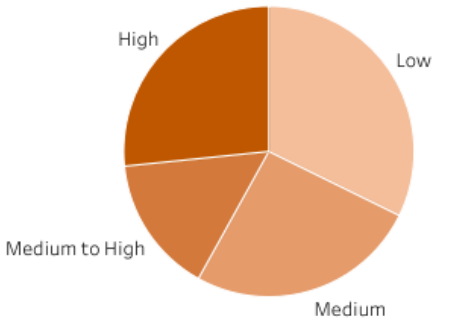

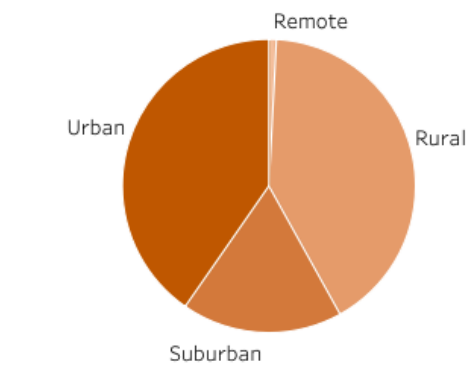

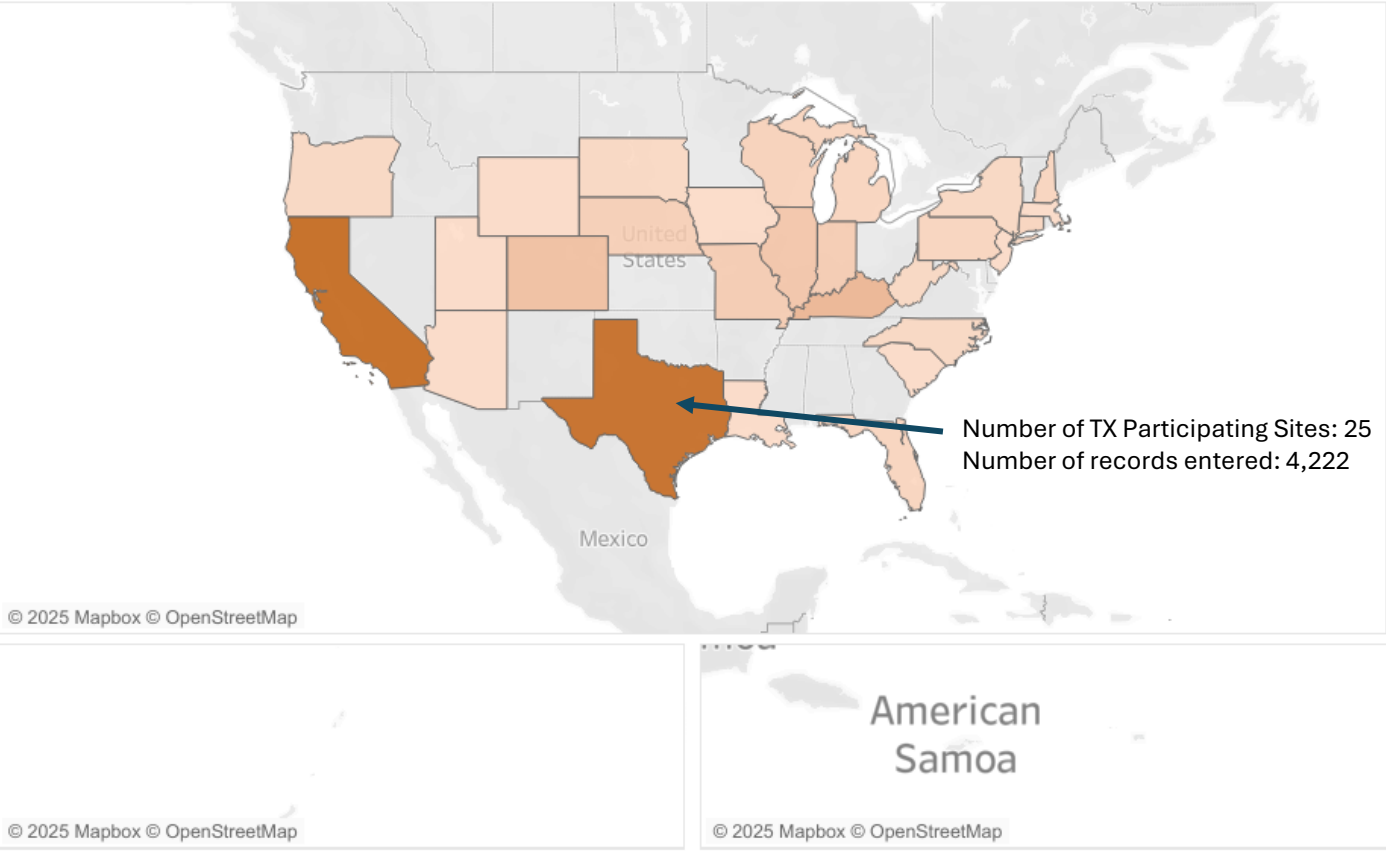
Number of Sites by Patient Volume Category

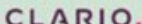

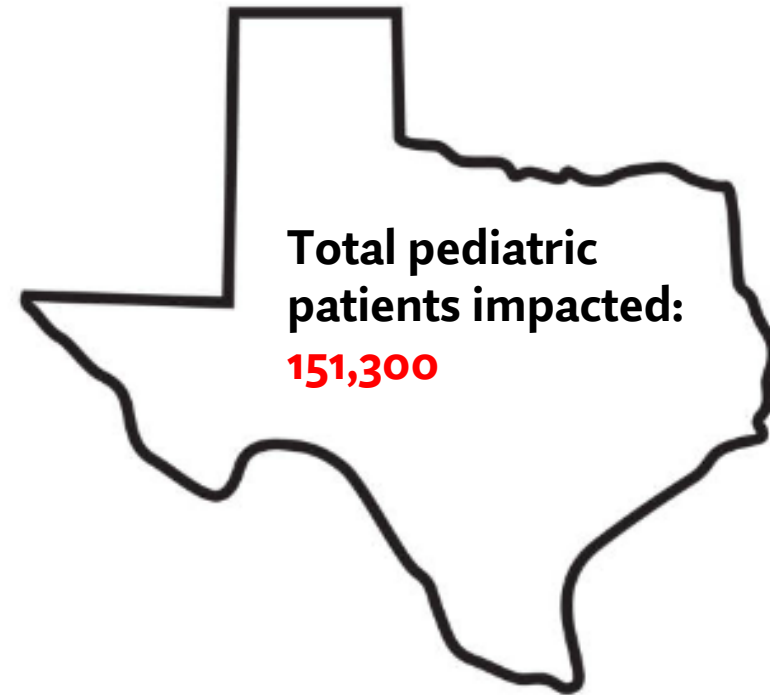
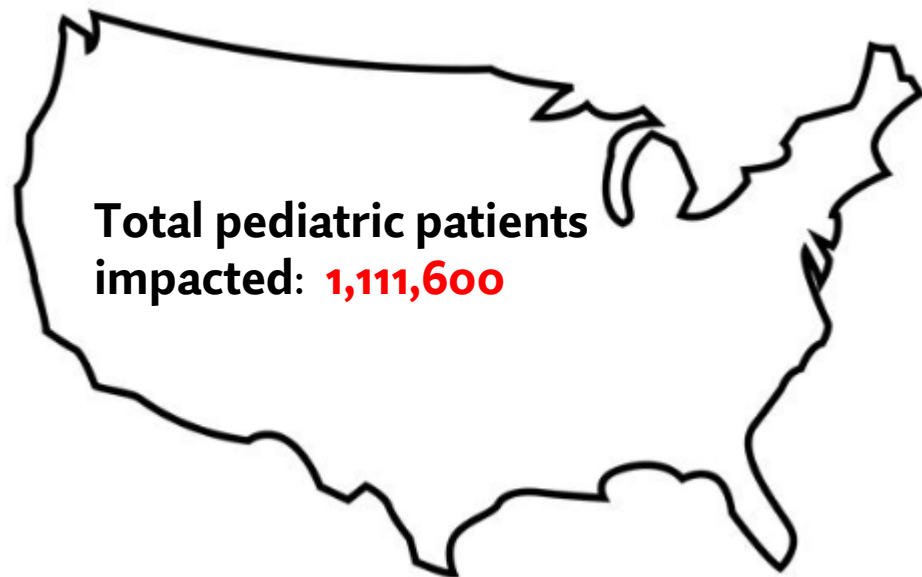
