  - iii. Vote: Whether to shift reporting of unstable injured patients transfer times to annual (Q1 - November) rather than semi-annual reporting
2. Door-to-Needle time for patients with acute ischemic stroke
3. Percent of EMS patients with primary impression of 'stroke' who have a stroke screening scale documented by EMS
4. Mean and Median pediatric readiness score for designated trauma centers
  - i. FY26 Q3 performance data
5. Number of severe maternal morbidity events per 1,000 live births
  - i. Vote on replacement measure
