## Read Labels to Make Informed Choices



Avoid products with danger or warning statements, when possible.

**DANGER** – most toxic; product may be harmful when swallowed, breathed in, or if gets on skin or in eyes

**WARNING** – moderately toxic

**CAUTION** – less toxic
