PLANNING

GOALS

- Identify goals and objectives that define long-term success within your community.
- Use the **Let's Talk** *SMART Goals* handout to develop objectives for short-term intermediate, and long-term outcomes.
- Use tools in the Let's Talk Safe Infant Sleep online toolkit to measure the impact of your community's objectives.

SUPPORT

- Identify champions who can support ongoing trainings, sustain follow-up support, and monitor community goals.
- To strengthen, extend, and sustain your circle of support for safe infant sleep, your organization may need external funding or ongoing commitment from a lead organization.
