

Living with HIV? Know someone who is? We are here for you.

If you or someone you know is living with HIV and needs support or services, the Ryan White HIV/AIDS program can help. This program offers access to medical care, medications, and essential support services for people living with HIV, regardless of their ability to pay.

How does the program work?

The Ryan White Program:

- Helps you cover the cost of HIV-related care services
- Covers you when your private insurance or Medicaid is unavailable or exhausted
- Ensures that you get the care you need even without insurance
- Works with nonprofit organizations across the state that specialize in HIV care and support



What services are available through the Ryan White program?

Ryan White Services may include, but are not limited to:

- HIV-related medical visits, lab work, and speciality care
- Case management (medical and non-medical)
- Referrals for healthcare services
- Mental health services
- Substance abuse outpatient care
- Oral health services
- Nutrition support and counseling
- Bus passes, ride shares, or door-to-door service for medical or support appointments
- Food vouchers, delivered meals, or gift cards

You may qualify for Ryan White services if you:

- Have a confirmed HIV diagnosis
- Live in Texas
- Have a household income **at or below** 500 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)

When you apply for Ryan White services, you will need to provide documentation for each point above and check in with the program every six months to update your information.
