

WHAT IS TIAP-PLUS?

The Texas HIV Medication Program (THMP) pays health insurance premiums for eligible uninsured Texans living with HIV through TIAP-PLUS.

WHAT COSTS WILL TIAP-PLUS COVER?

TIAP-PLUS covers costs associated with medication needs, including:

- Health insurance premiums –
 A premium is the regular monthly payment you make to your health insurance company to keep your coverage active.
- Medication copayments –
 A copayment is a fixed amount you pay for your prescription drugs when you have health insurance.
- Medication deductibles –
 A deductible is the amount you pay out-of-pocket for prescription drugs before your insurance plan starts to cover costs.



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
