

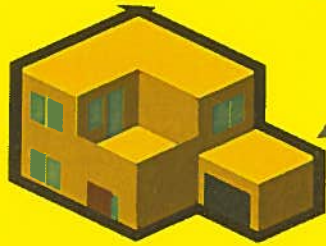

- Conduct onsite visit annually or as needed to monitor and evaluate local agencies process and system flow to aid in the alleviation of barriers for clients and prevention of lapsing program benefits. As well as, monitor compliance for the service standard Referral for Healthcare/ Benefits Counseling (RFHC).
- Conduct trainings and ongoing Technical Assistance to ensure compliance around accuracy of ADAP applications before submission to DSHS-THMP.
- Develop best practice and adopt systems such as (ARIES) to aids in the application process and communication between the ADAP Enrollment Worker (AEW) and DSHS-THMP.
- Continual communication with DSHS-THMP Regional Coordinator regarding AEW error trends and providing feedback regarding support needed from DSHS-THMP on the local level.
- Assist with planning and coordination of DSHS-THMP AEW regional meetings (face to face or webinars).
- Liaison ongoing updates from Federal, State, and Local guidance.
