

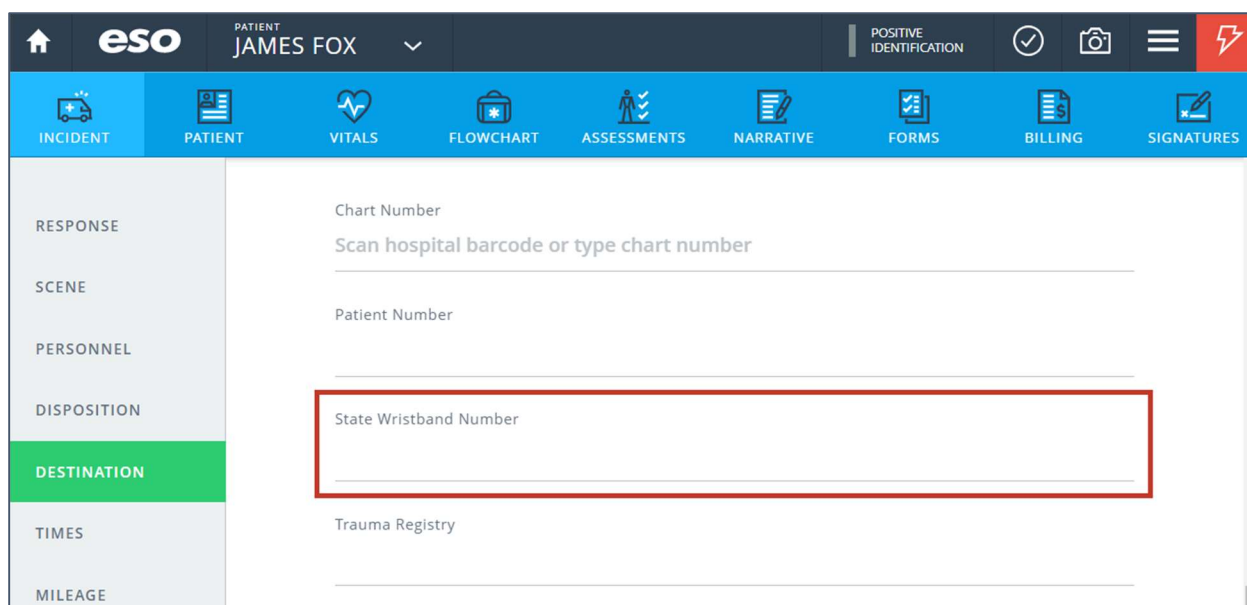
Overview

To expedite reconciliation of patients as they move through the prehospital and hospital systems and to track clinical records and outcomes to improve care, states are developing wristband programs. ESO had added a purpose-built field in EHR for EMS clinicians to record the wristband number as the band is applied during patient contact.

NOTE: These instructions apply to agencies in Georgia and Texas who are participating in the state's wristband initiative. Agencies in other states should continue to report wristband or patient identification numbers as previously instructed or contact the ESO support team for assistance.

User Experience

When enabled, the State Wristband Number field may be found in EHR on the Incident Tab in the Destination section. An optional validation rule can be enabled to require that this field be completed when the disposition indicates the patient was transported.

What's needed

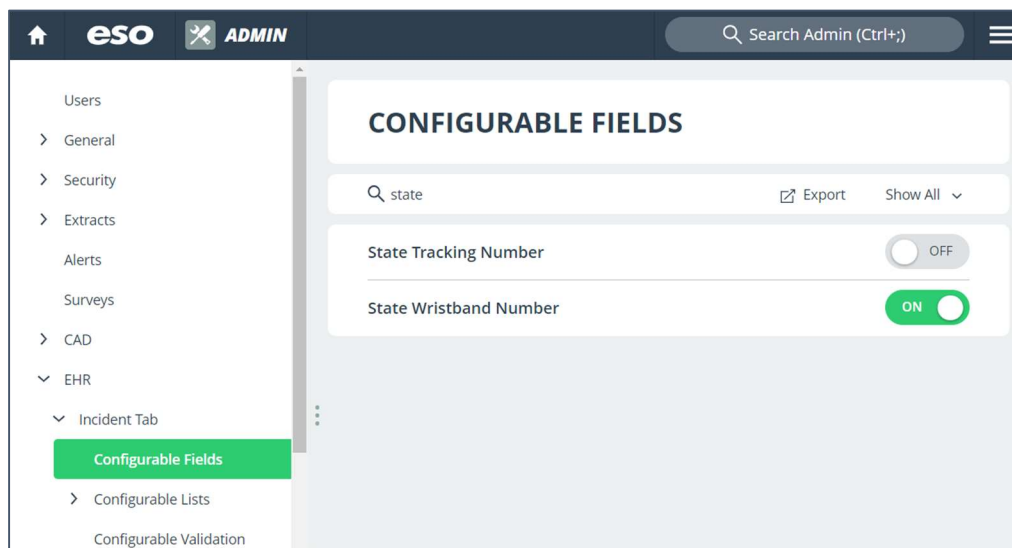
- This guide is intended for users with administrator rights to manage users in ESO Suite.
- Use of the State Wristband Number field requires EHR Mobile version 5.37.1861.0 or later.

Enabling State Wristband Reporting

Steps

1. Open a web browser and navigate to <https://www.esosuite.net> and login.
2. From the landing page, Launch the Admin module.
3. To enable the State Wristband Number field
 - a. In Admin, navigate to EHR > Incident Tab > Configurable Fields
 - b. Locate State Wristband Number and turn it on

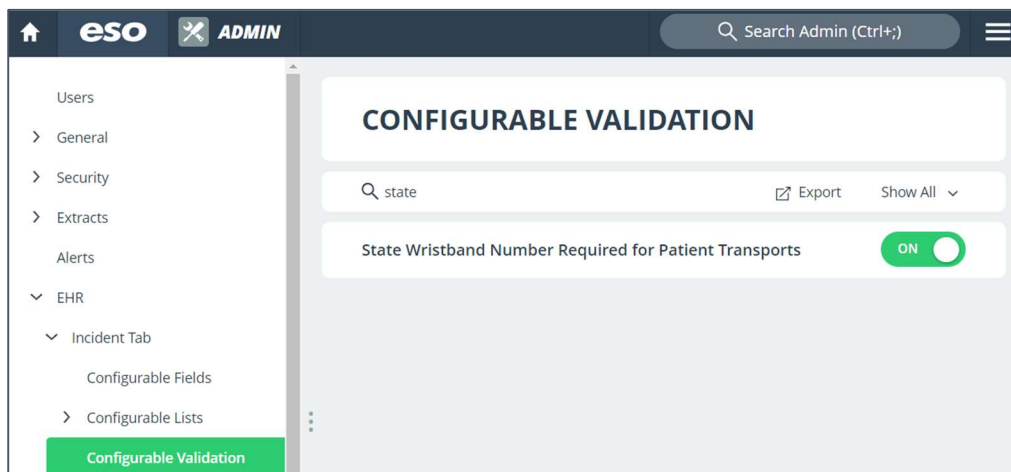
NOTE: To avoid end-user confusion and ensure proper reporting to your state EMS data repository, we recommend you disable the State Tracking Number field.



4. To enforce the completion of the State Wristband Number field, an optional configurable validation rule may be enabled
 - a. In Admin, navigate to EHR > Incident Tab > Configurable Validation
 - b. Locate the desired validation rule and turn it on

State Wristband Number Required for Patient Transports – This validation rule requires the completion of the State Wristband Number field when the disposition is a patient transport.

NOTE: The disposition Wheelchair Transport is excluded from this validation rule.
