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## Introduction

Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Registries (EMSTR) is a statewide surveillance system collecting reportable event data from EMS providers, hospitals, justices of the peace, medical examiners, long term acute care facilities (LTACs), and rehabilitation facilities. EMSTR includes four registries:

- The EMS registry;
- The Acute Traumatic Injury registry;
- The Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) registry and Spinal Cord Injury (SCI) registry; and
- The Submersion registry.

EMSTR monitors and analyzes Texas EMS and trauma care system data by integrating National EMS Information System (NEMIS) Version 3.5 format, National Trauma Data Bank (NTDB) standards, International Trauma Data Exchange (ITDX) 2020 and 2023 hospital data standards, and Texas-specific questions.

EMSTR uses data from 22 Texas trauma services areas / regional advisory councils (RACs) to benchmark and compare Texas with other states and conduct epidemiological investigations to identify public health issues. By identifying public health issues, stakeholders can use data to support injury prevention initiatives, enhancing the efficiency and quality of care for patients in Texas.

This State Health Analytics Reporting Platform (SHARP) Reports Guide provides an overview of each SHARP report and instructions to run the reports for EMSTR users who submit data and have report access.

EMSTR is governed by Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Title 25, Part 1, [Chapter 103](#).

## SHARP Reports

The SHARP system is a Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) data analytics platform comprised of a data warehouse, data governance tools, and various data analytics and visualization tools working together to collectively support data analytics, governance, and reporting.

The EMSTR system enhancement provides new user reports. In addition to the No Reportable Data (NRD), Data Submission, and Submission Status-IML Files reports, users have access to up to 11 reports in the system.

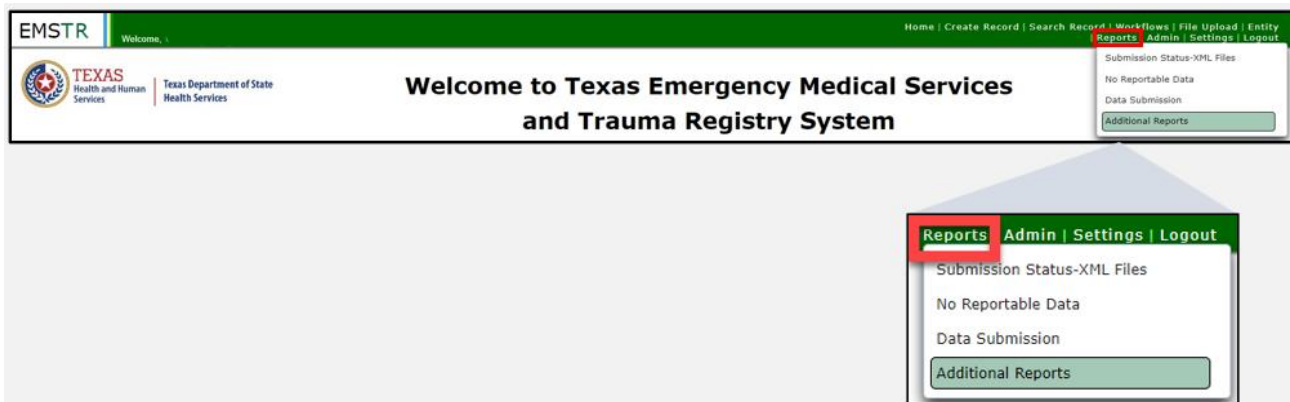

### Hospital Data Validity Report

The **Hospital Data Validity Report** compiles aggregate data monthly, quarterly, and yearly by individual element and the associated element group. Record details include record counts, and percentage of valid, valid null, and invalid records.

After selecting the **Hospital Data Validity Report**, select the “**Year**”, “**RAC Name**”, then “**Entity Name**” from the drop-down fields.

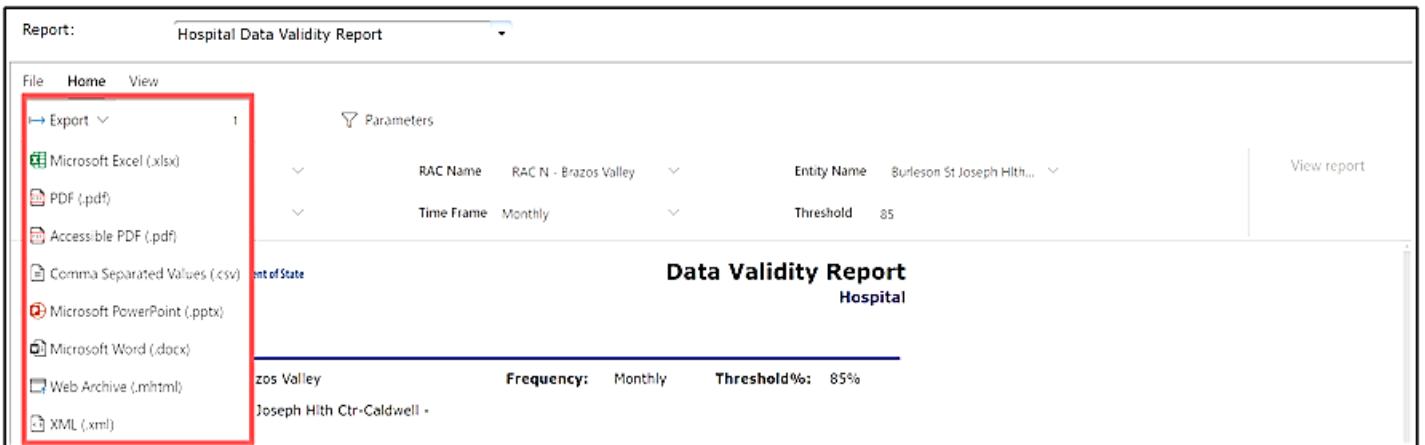

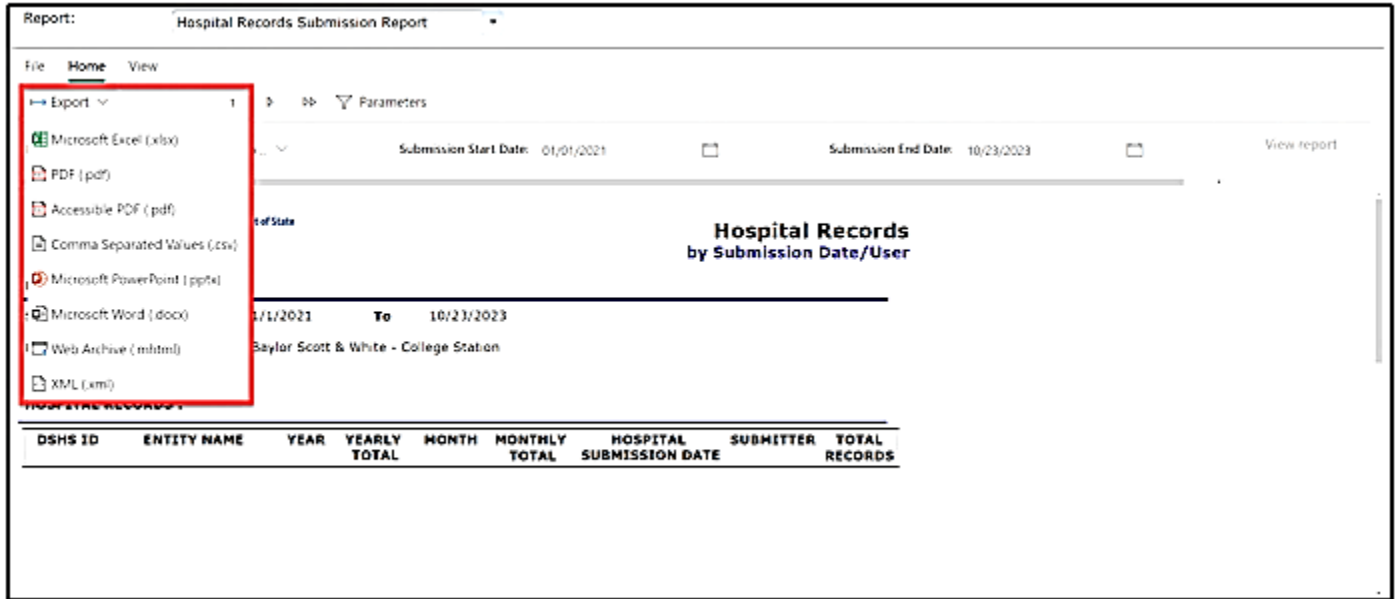


## Hospital Records Submission Report

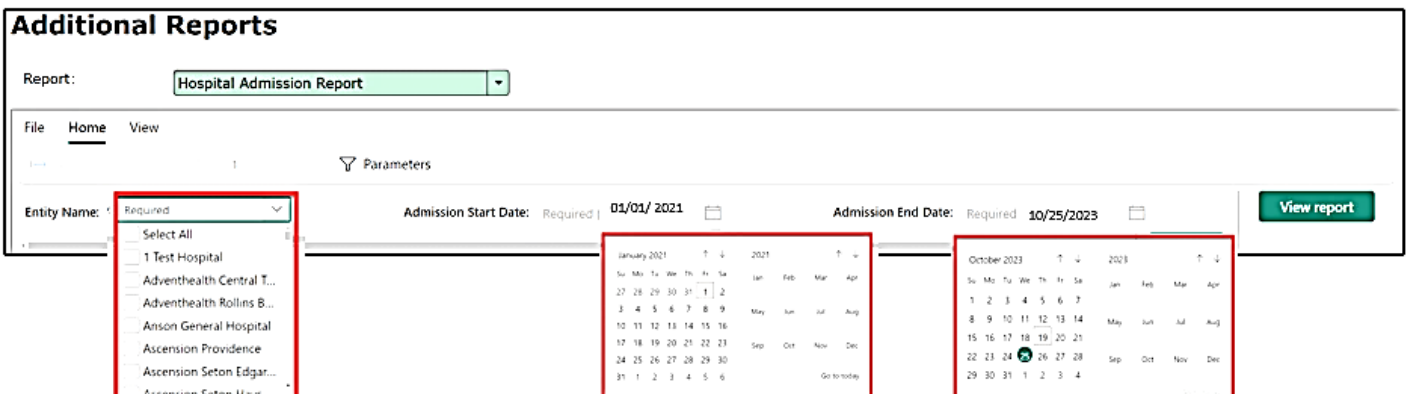


After selecting the **View report** button, the report will display with the selected parameters. Select the **“Export”** drop-down button and choose the appropriate file format to download the report.

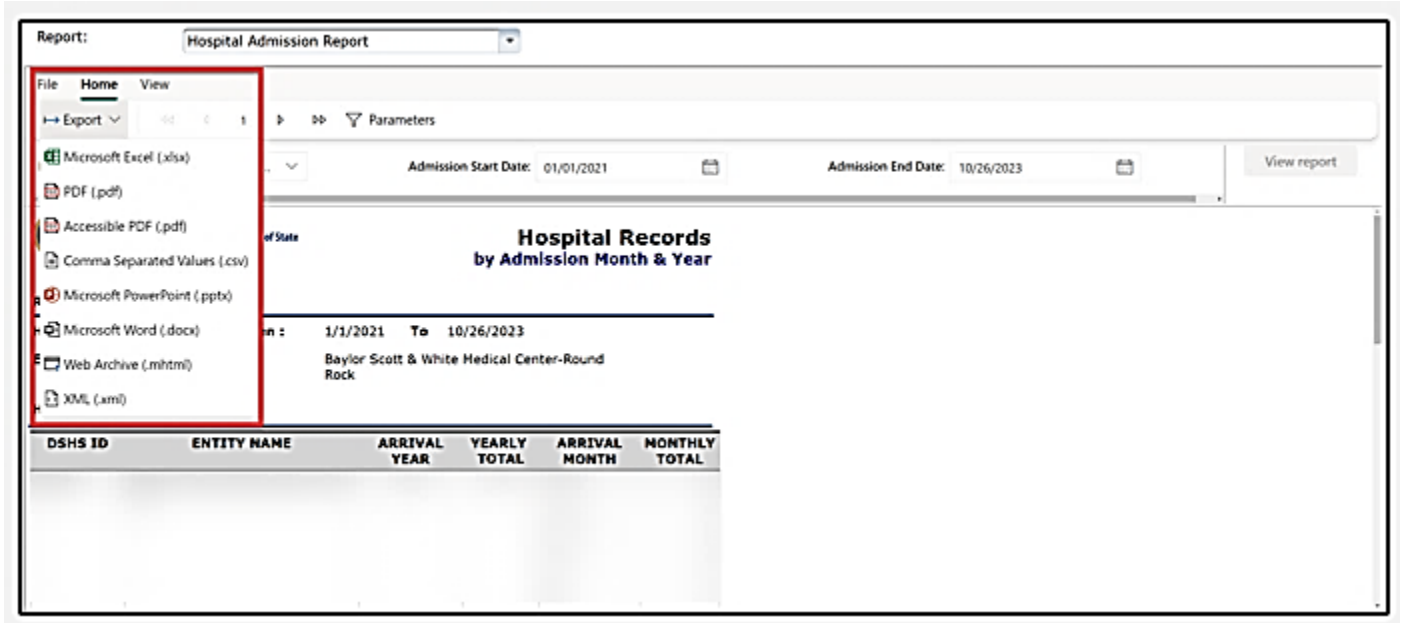


## Hospital Admission Report

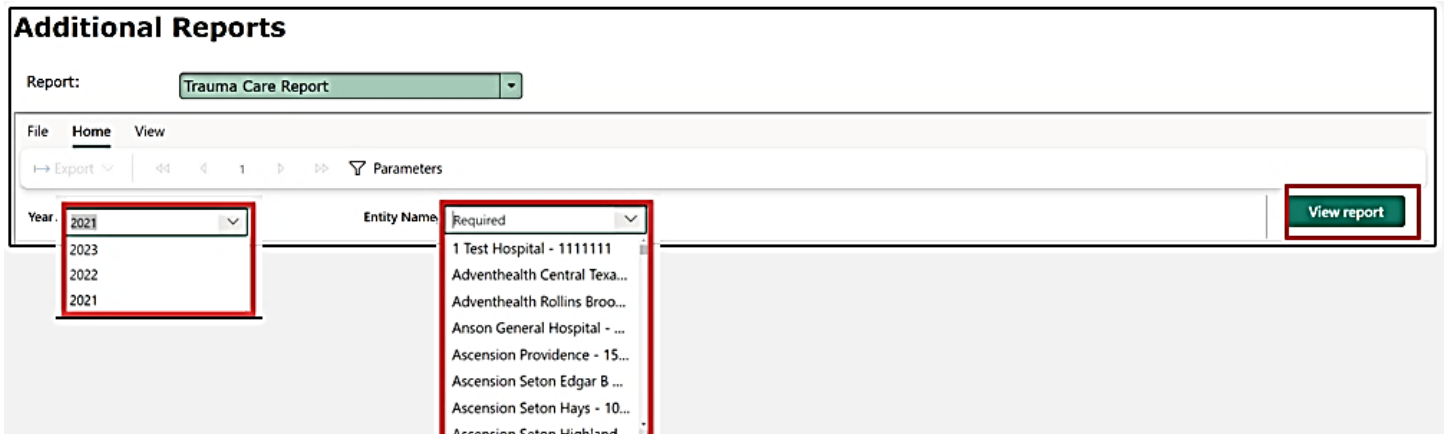


Select the **“View report”** button. The report will display with the selected parameters. To download the report, select the **“Export”** drop-down button and choose the appropriate file format.

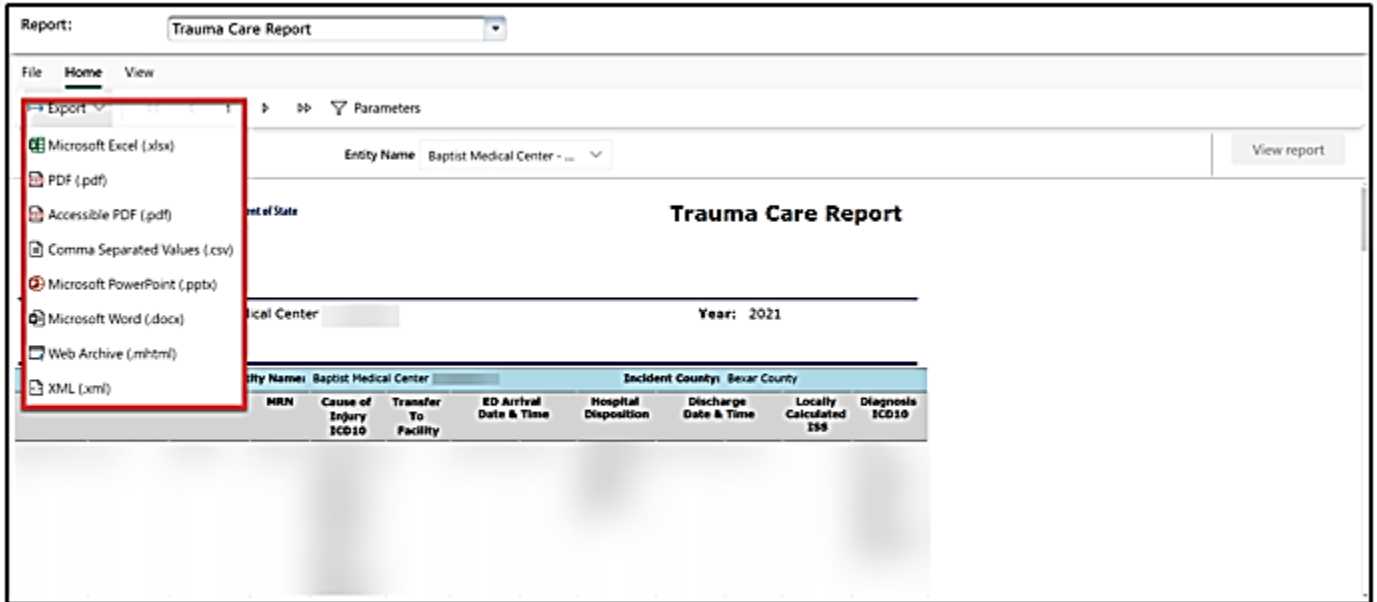


## Trauma Care Report

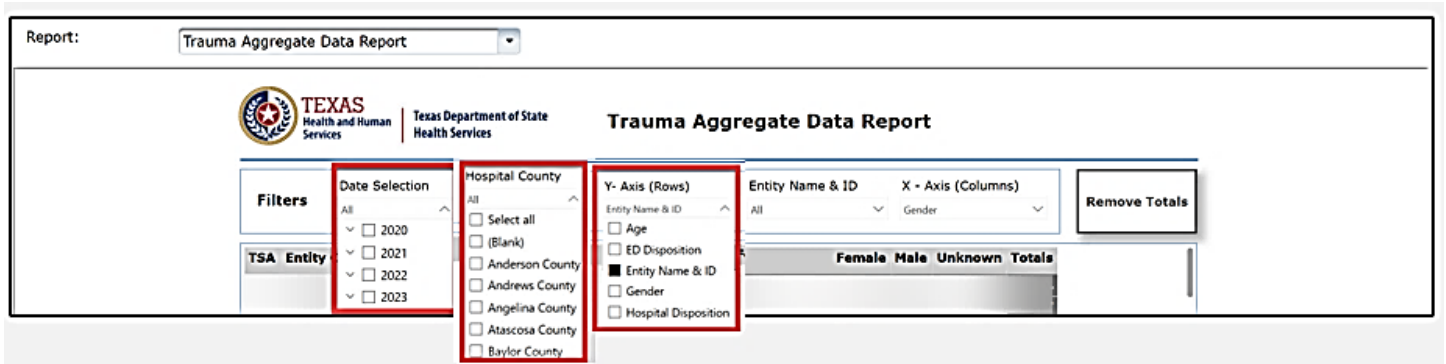

## Trauma Aggregate Data Report

The **Trauma Aggregate Data Report** provides insight into aggregate case counts (by entity ID) for their facility or entire region with the option to include different variables as needed.

Select the **“Data Selection”**, **“Hospital County”**, **“Y-Axis (Rows)”**, **“Entity Name & ID”**, and **“X-Axis (Columns)”** from the drop-down fields.



The information in the report will update based on the filters selected.

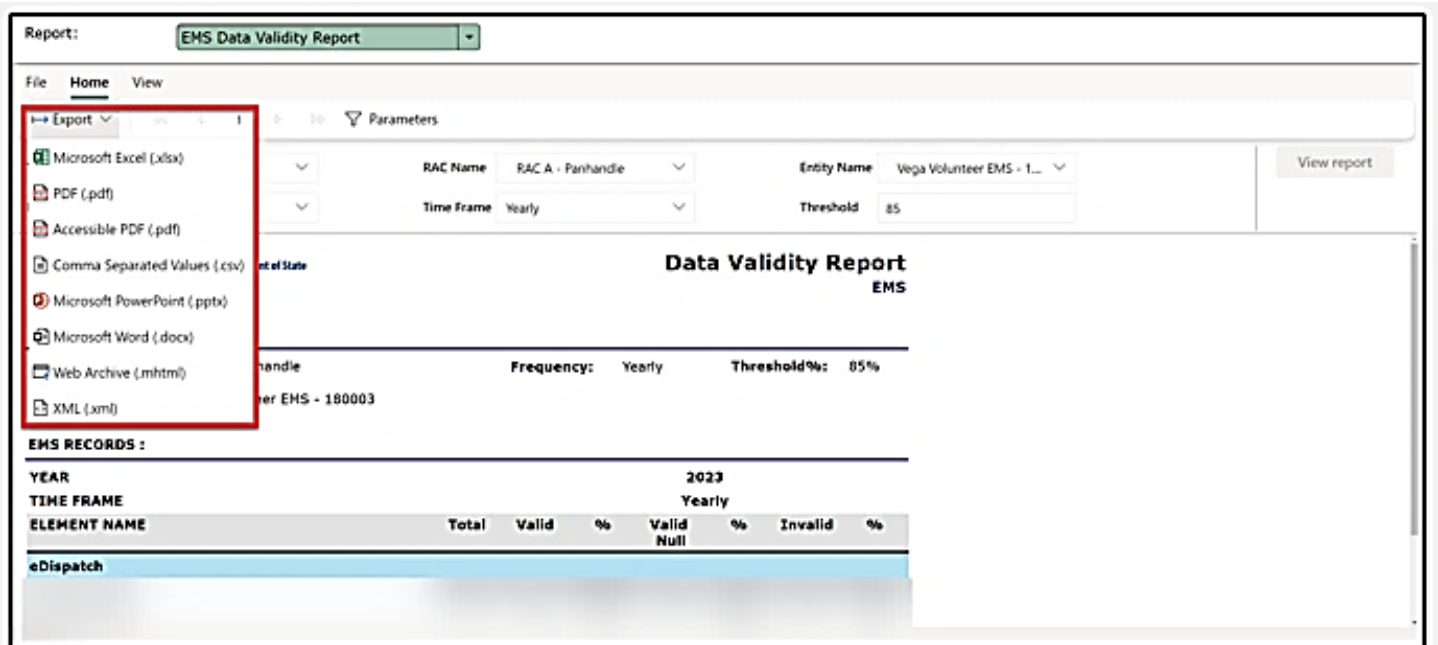

Select the “**Element Group(s)**”, “**Time Frame**”, and “**Threshold**” from the drop-down fields. Then select the “**View report**” button. **NOTE: Threshold** is the percentage of invalid entries for a given element field.

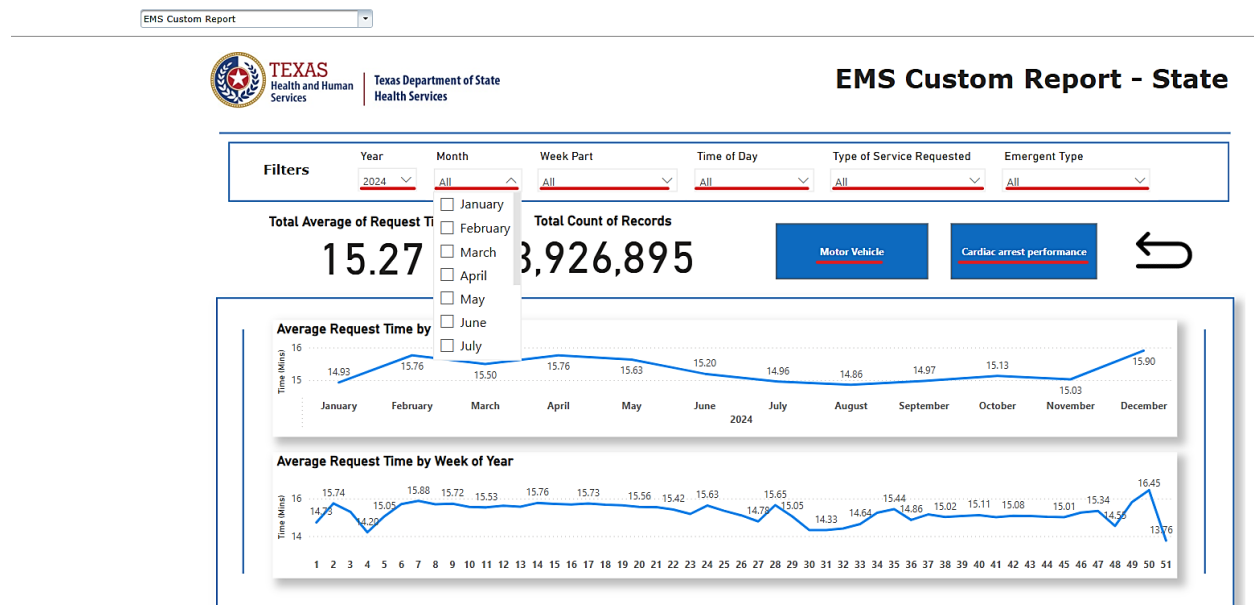

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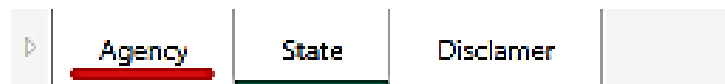
## EMS Custom Report

The **EMS Custom Report** provides a dashboard with an agency's aggregate **EMS Request Times**. Users can review an agency's EMS request time data using filters for disposition, time, and other situational determinants. This data is also available for motor vehicle responses and cardiac arrests.

**NOTE: Request Time** is defined by the time elapsed between the **Public Safety Answer Point (PSAP)** timestamp (eTimes.01) and the **Unit Arrival on Scene** timestamp (eTimes.06).



In the bottom left corner of the screen, users can toggle between statewide and agency-level versions of the report to compare data.



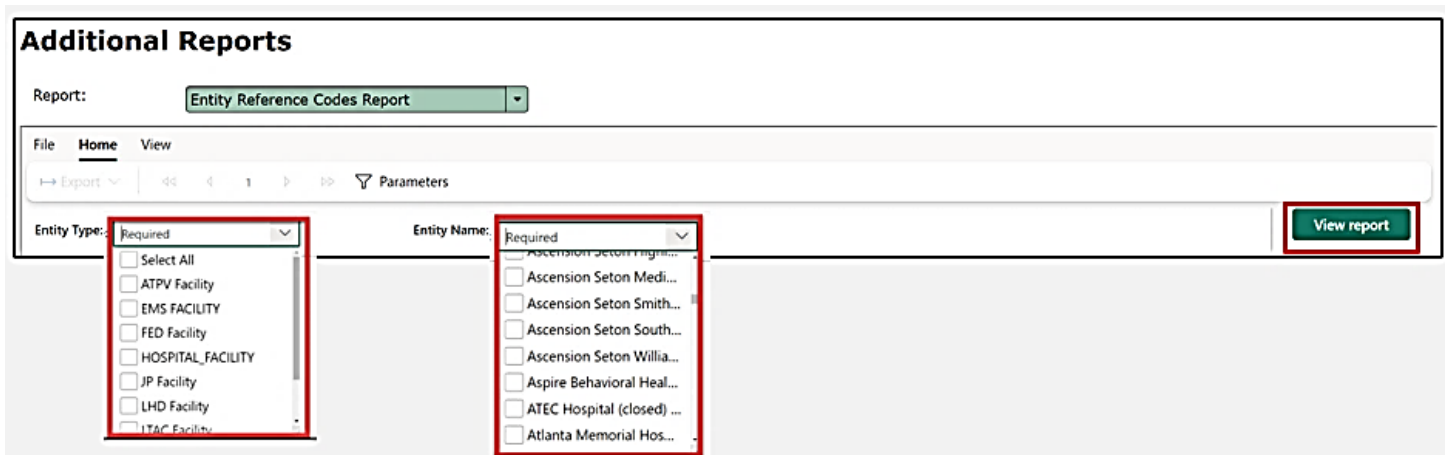

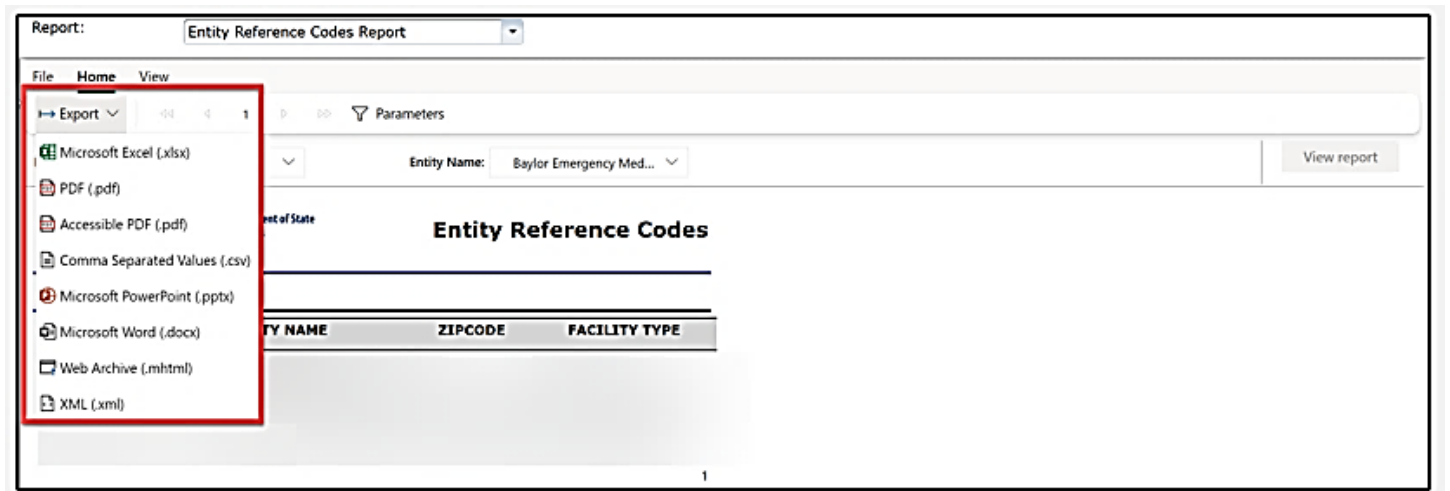

### Entity Reference Codes Report

The **Entity Reference Codes Report** lets any user search for a facility to find the DSHS ID, address, and zip code. Select **“Entity Type”** and **“Entity Name”** from the drop-down fields. Then select the **“View report”** button.

## Entity No Reportable Data Report
