# **Infectious Substance Category A**

An infectious substance in a form capable of causing permanent disability or life threatening or fatal disease in otherwise healthy humans or animals when exposure to it occurs

- -Use identification number UN2814 for <u>Infectious substances</u>, <u>affecting humans</u>
- -Use identification number UN2900 for <u>Infectious substances</u>, <u>affecting animals</u>


# **Infectious Substance Category B**

An infectious substance **NOT** in a form generally capable of causing permanent disability or life threatening or fatal disease in otherwise healthy humans or animals when exposure to it occurs —Use identification number UN3373

# **Exempt Human or Animal Specimen**

DOT does not have this category in their regulations. According to DOT, exempt human or animal specimens are not subject to requirements as Division 6.2 material
