## Dear Governor Abbott:

<u>Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 481.0355</u>, requires the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to report any emergency scheduling action taken in the preceding two-year period. The report must be submitted no later than December 1 of each even-numbered year.

Emergency scheduling allows Texas to respond quickly to emerging drug threats not addressed by other avenues, including federal drug schedules. Following the addition of emergency scheduling in Texas, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) separately implemented a process to publish amendments to federal drug schedules more quickly. DSHS has not initiated any independent emergency scheduling actions during the preceding two-year period due to the improvement in DEA scheduling.
