Dear Acting Comptroller Hancock:

Texas Health and Safety Code (HSC), Section [311.045](#), requires nonprofit hospitals and hospital systems to report community benefits and charity care information to the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). HSC, Section [311.0455](#), requires DSHS to submit an annual report listing each nonprofit hospital that did not meet the requirements during the preceding fiscal year. The statute requires DSHS to deliver the report by July 1 each year. This year, an extension was granted to October 27, 2025, due to the timing of data availability.

All nonprofit hospitals required to submit the 2024 Annual Statement of Community Benefits met obligations for community benefits and charity care reporting.
