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Preface

Pursuant to the 2026-2027 General Appropriations Act, S.B.1, 89th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 2025 (Department of State Health Services Rider 10, Other Reporting Requirements - Fees), Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has reviewed fees for Fiscal Year 2025 and acknowledged that the rider revised the submission date to be no later than January 31 of each year of the biennium.

This manual compiles basic information about fee programs administered by DSHS during FY 2025. Amounts in this report are based on FY 2025/Appropriation Year 2025 for the period of September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025. Information contained in this manual includes date of origin, statutory authority, a brief description of each fee, revenue history and deposit coding information. Fringe benefits are included in costs reported. A methodology is only included when a fee is changed.



Asbestos Removal Licensure

Description:	Fees related to licensing of persons engaged in asbestos abatement or any asbestos-related activity. This includes licensing fees, exam fees and notification fees. Fees may only be used for the purposes of asbestos health protection. Not more than 25% may be used for administration and the remainder shall be used for additional enforcement personnel necessary to investigate compliance.





Food, Drug, and Medical Device Wholesale Distribution / Manufacturing

Description:	A license for each place of business is required for a person to engage in wholesale distribution, which is the selling of large quantities of Food or Drugs (non-prescription or prescription) that will be sold by retailers. A license for each place of business is required for a person to engage in the manufacturing of Food or Drugs, which includes but is not limited to, preparing, compounding, processing, packaging, or repackaging, or labeling a food or drug product. A license for each place of business is required in order for a person to engage in the manufacture and the wholesale distribution of medical devices such as pacemakers, powered wheelchairs, or breast implants.
