## Region 8 Activities

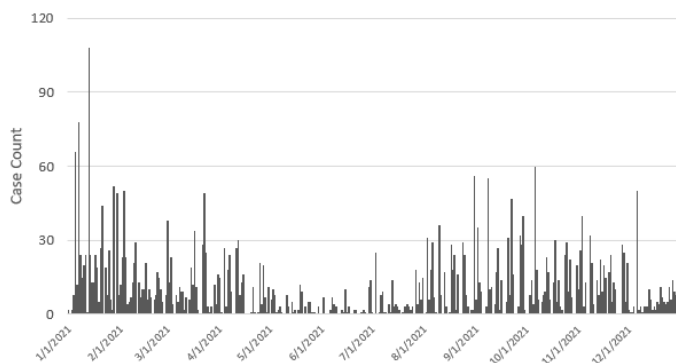
- Inspect child car seats and teach parents/caregivers how to use them correctly
- Promote breastfeeding education and resources to new and current moms
- Participated with Kerr/Gillespie/Bandera counties to form Kendall County Child Fatality Review Team
- Provide COVID-19 guidance/updates to the community and county leaders
- Provide immunizations to infants, children, and adults who meet the requirements for Vaccines for Children and Adult Safety Net program
- Serve as a resource for school nurses, health care providers, and day cares on immunizations and notifiable conditions
- Educate the community about STDs
- Recruit and educate Texas Vaccines for Children providers
- Audit local schools and childcare providers for compliance with immunization requirements
- Conduct provider visits, distribute resources, and educate providers about notifiable conditions and reporting requirements

## Immunizations

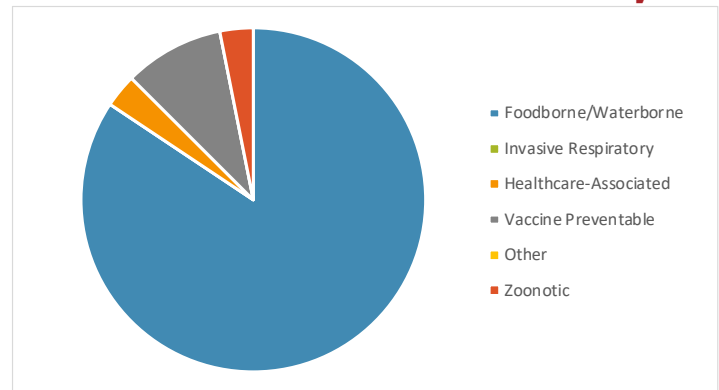
- The percent of school students with a conscientious exemption from immunizations filed at the school district level in Kendall County is 3.62% up from 3.60% in 2020

## 2021 Public Health by the Numbers
