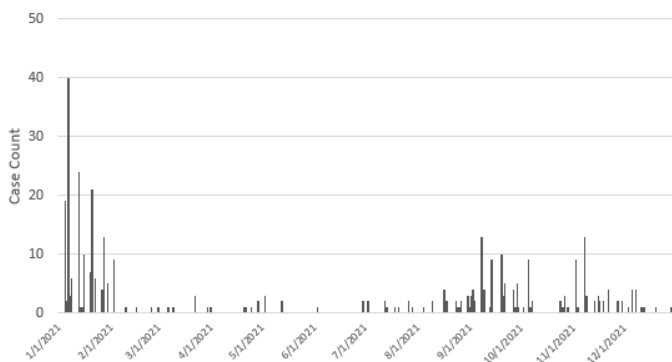
### Region 8 Activities

- Organize the 2021 Child Abuse Prevention Virtual Summit

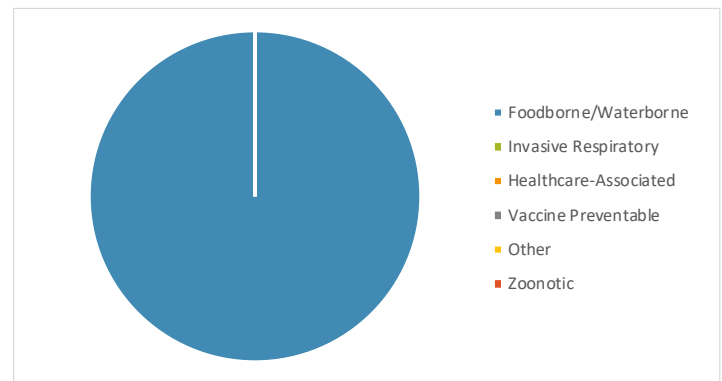
### Immunizations
