Region 8 Activities

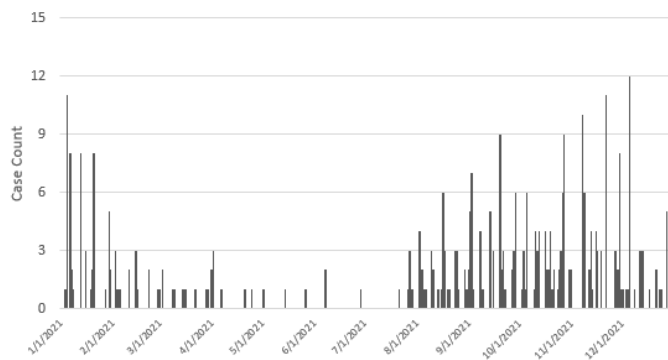
- Provide COVID-19 vaccinations at community-based clinics
- Serve on the School Health Advisory Council and the Real County Community Initiative
- Assist school nurses with immunizations, notifiable conditions and required disease reporting
- Organize the Real County Child Fatality Review Team to review child deaths and recommend prevention strategies
- Educate area residents about heat stroke prevention, water safety and other important health topics
- Conduct a child car seat check up to distribute, install and inspect car seats and educate parents or guardians about their correct use

Immunizations

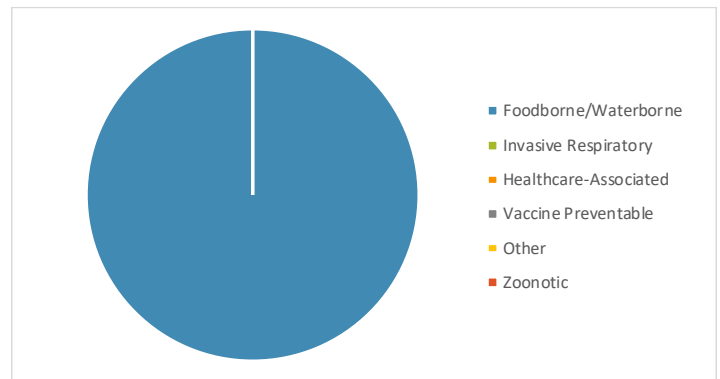
- The percent of school students with a conscientious exemption from immunizations filed at the school district level in Real County is 0.0% down from 0.59% in 2020
