## **Notifiable Conditions Report: October 2025**

This report includes all notifiable conditions reported to the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Public Health Region 8 (PHR 8) Epidemiology and Zoonosis Control Programs that meet confirmed or probable case criteria and have an event date occurring in the report month. Event date is the first date available of: symptom onset date, lab collection date, lab result date or date of report to public health.

This report includes all counties within DSHS PHR 8, excluding Bexar County where all infectious disease investigations are conducted by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District. The infectious diseases included in this report are received and investigated by DSHS PHR 8 Epidemiology and Zoonosis programs, the Comal County Office of Public Health, or the Victoria County Public Health Department.

Data are obtained from the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System (NEDSS). All data are subject to change pending quality assurance analysis.

#### Summary of Condition Types

#### **Food and Waterborne**

Food and waterborne illnesses spread when people consume contaminated food products or water. These germs can cause illness, hospitalization and death. Common symptoms are diarrhea, stomach cramps, nausea, vomiting and fever. The best way to prevent food and waterborne illnesses is to wash your hands often and clean the surfaces where you prepare food in your home. Keep raw meat, chicken, seafood and eggs separate from other foods to prevent cross-contamination and ensure your drinking water is clean and safe. #### Zoonoses

Zoonotic diseases are caused by germs that spread from animals to humans. Petting or touching animals, living in shared environments with animals, and getting bites from animals or insects are all ways that zoonotic diseases can spread to humans. You can protect yourself against zoonotic diseases in several ways. Always wash your hands after coming in contact with animals. Do not touch or approach wild animals, especially if they seem sick. Protect yourself from insect and animal bites when outdoors. Keep your pets and livestock healthy by vaccinating them and having regular visits with your veterinarian.
