

**STERILIZATION RECORDS SHALL BE PERMANENTLY RECORDED AND MADE AVAILABLE FOR EXAMINATION BY AN AUTHORIZED AGENT IN THE STUDIO FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE LAST ENTRY.**

Sterilized instruments stored in an approved manner and not used within 30 days after sterilization shall no longer be considered sterile and shall be re-sterilized before use, unless the studio or temporary location utilizes presterilized instruments sterilized by a manufacturer. If presterilized instruments are used, the artist shall obtain documentation from the manufacturer that describes the method of sterilization utilized by the manufacturer and the manufacturer's recommendations for storage and maintenance of sterility. This documentation shall be available for inspection by an authorized agent. The artist shall follow the manufacturer's instructions for storage and maintenance of sterility.
