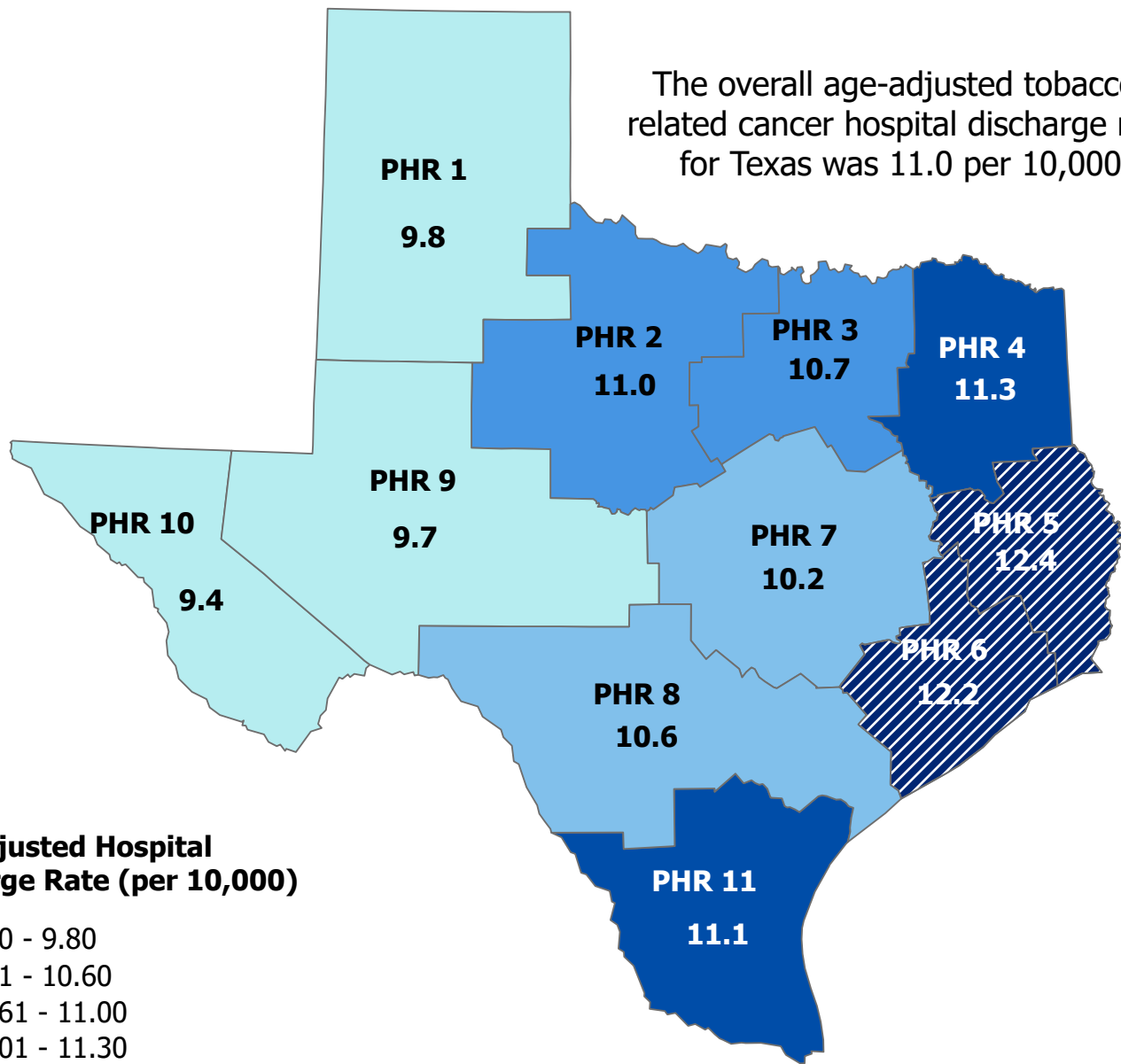
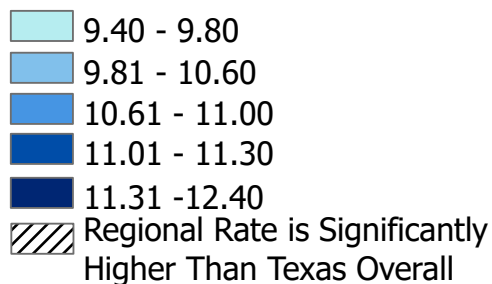

Tobacco-related cancer hospitalization is defined as a hospital record listing ICD-10 codes C00-C16, C18-C20, C22, C25-C26, C32-C34, C53, C64-C65, C67, or C92 as the principal diagnosis. If there were fewer than 12 hospitalizations recorded for a county, corresponding rates were not reported.



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
