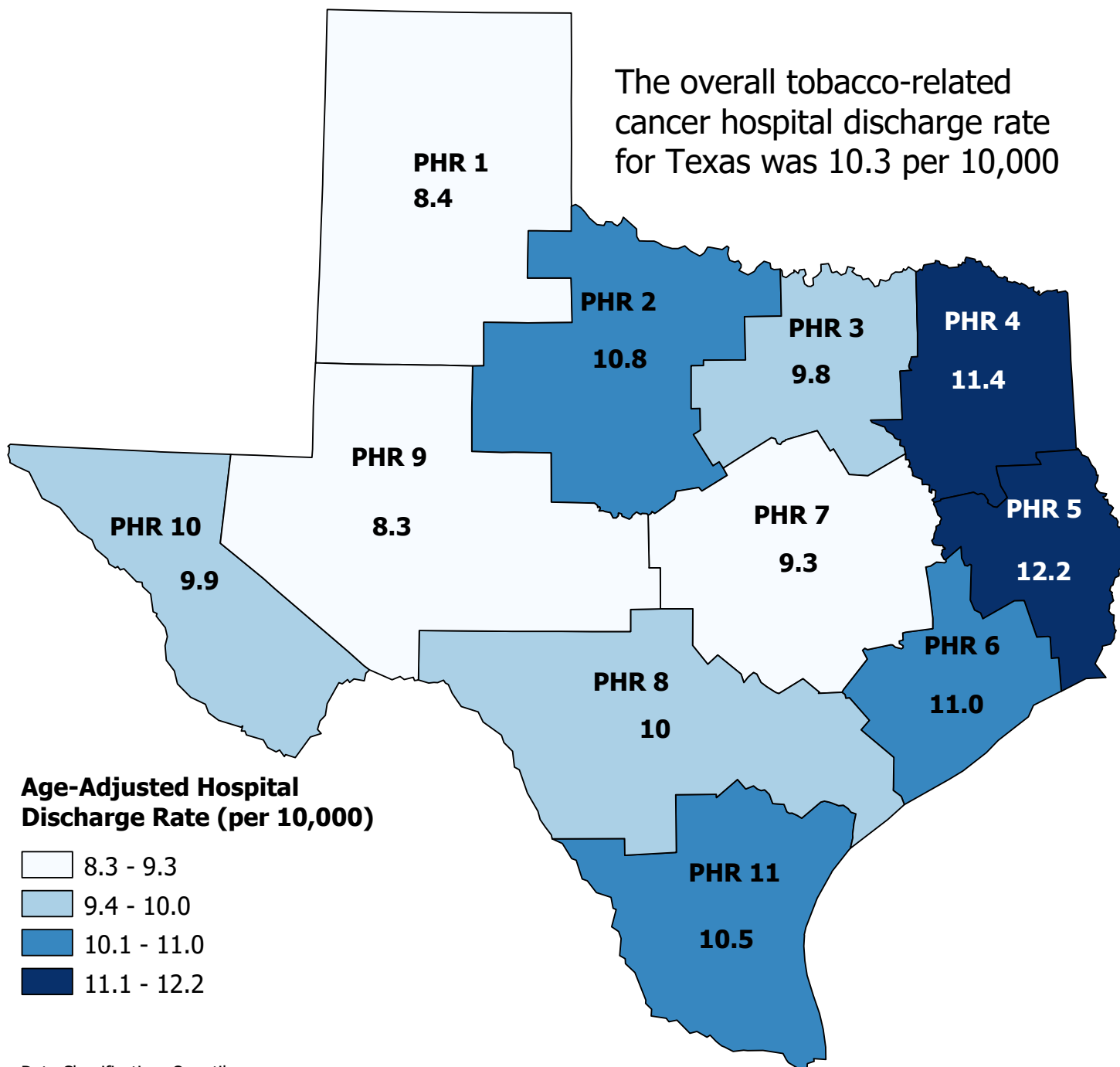


Age-Adjusted Tobacco-Related Cancer Hospital Discharge Rates (per 10,000) by Public Health Region (PHR), Texas 2021
