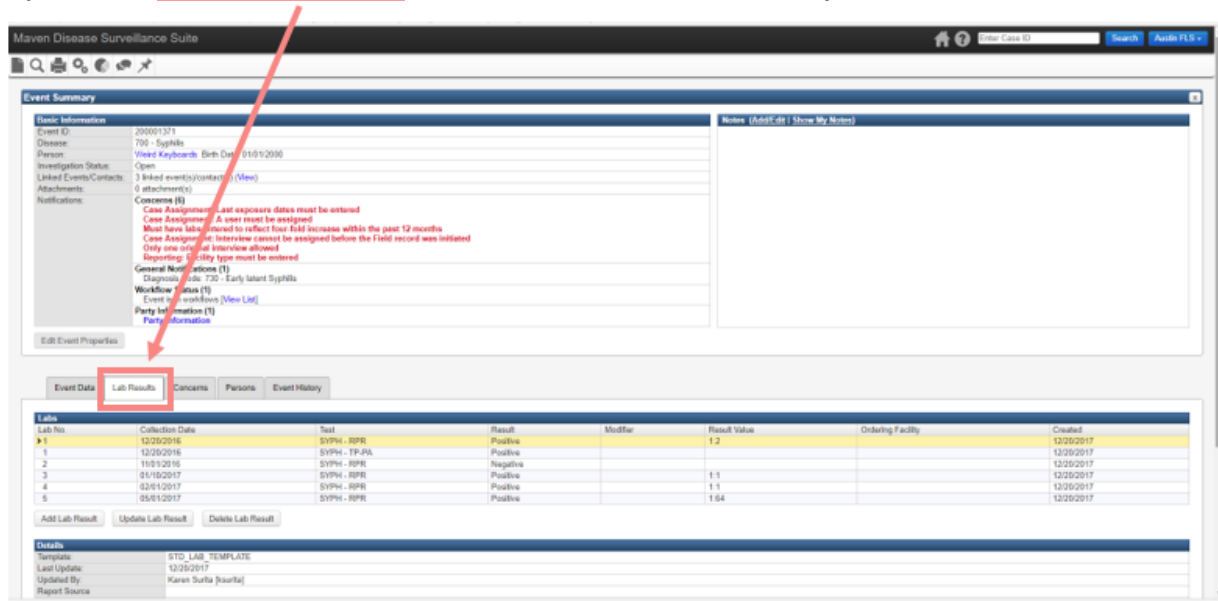


Deleting Laboratory Results in THISIS

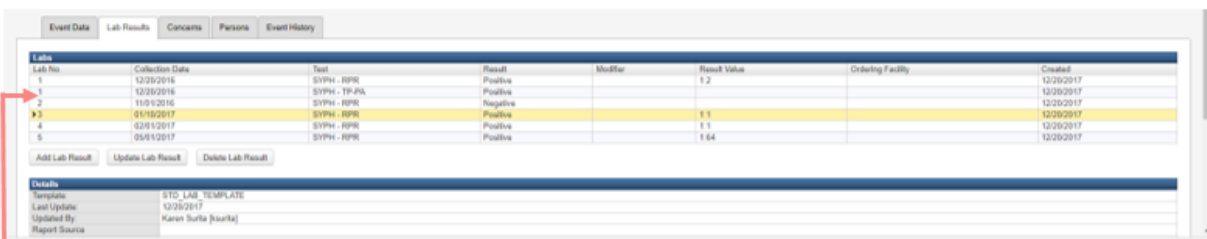
In THISIS, it is possible to delete an entire lab report, as well as to delete a single lab result, from a lab report. Deleting an entire lab report in the system is permanent so it is important to understand the difference and know how to perform both skills.

Deleting an Entire Lab Report

Open the **Lab Results** tab within the event summary screen.

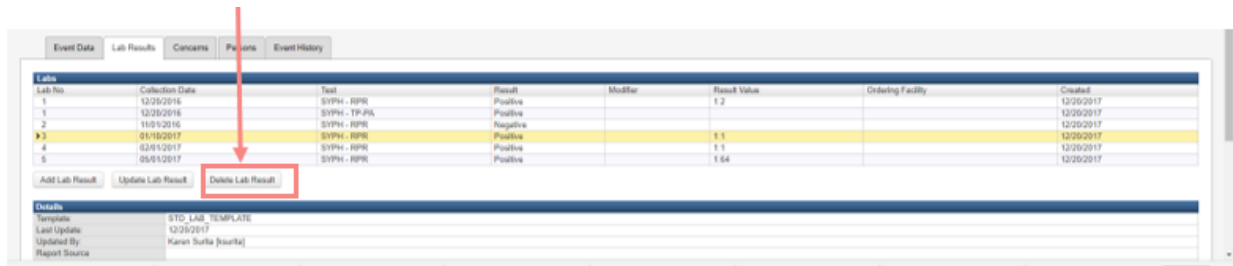


In the Labs section, **select the lab report to be deleted**. The lab report being deleted will be highlighted in yellow

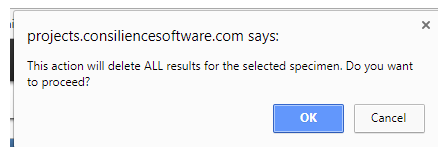


This highlighted line is the lab report to be deleted

Verify that the lab report highlighted is the correct report to be deleted. Once you have verified selection of the correct lab report, select the **Delete Lab Result** button at the bottom of the Labs section.



A pop-up warning will appear stating, "This action will delete ALL results for the selected specimen. Do you want to proceed?" Once you are certain that it is safe to delete all results from the selected specimen, **select OK** to delete all results from the selected specimen.

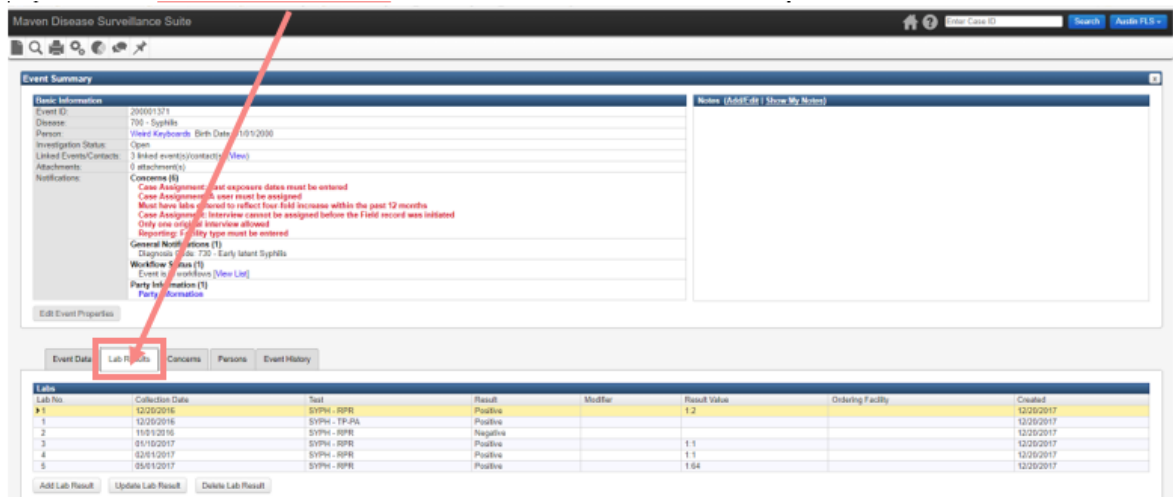


NOTE – Deleting a lab result from the Lab Results tab is permanent, and cannot be reversed. Please verify that it is absolutely necessary to delete this lab prior to selecting this option.

Deleting an Individual Lab Result

The following procedures should be used to delete just one result from a lab report.

Open the **Lab Results** tab within the event summary screen.



In the Labs section, click on the lab report that contains the result you wish to delete. The lab report being altered will be highlighted in yellow.
