Emergency response efforts, as needed. In collaboration with the EPR Disability Specialist, this position analyzes and compiles surveillance data from a variety of sources, creates reports and makes public health mitigation/intervention recommendations to the EPR Team Lead and the EEP Director. Work is performed under limited supervision with moderate latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgement.
