Perform monthly operations and activities as requested by the Texas Public Health Fellowship program. Under the general direction of the Health Services Director, Public Health Deputy, and Community Health Nurse, the Community Health Fellow will perform high level communication, outreach, and project-development to support the local health department and increase public and stakeholder knowledge and awareness of public health issues, including work on health disparities. Work in collaboration with Public Health programs to develop, deliver, and implement public health information materials aimed at internal and external audiences. The Community Health fellow will foster, manage, and strengthen partnerships with various community stakeholders; support growth of community trust and presence; create/modify and disseminate educational materials for ethnically, racially, and age-related diverse audiences, especially those in the Hispanic/Latino community; Organize and prepare materials on specific subjects of public health interest, including health disparities, immunizations, WIC, public health emergency preparedness and response, and utilize various resources such as audio-visuals, handouts, visual aids, etc.; Conduct outreach to identified or targeted populations based on CHNA results, to deliver preparedness, prevention, and response messages; Identify stakeholders in the community and in targeted populations to establish sustainable partnerships; Promote community events, outreach activities, and campaigns including marketing health education materials; Perform other related professional duties which contribute to program/contract goals including trainings, meeting attendance, and record maintenance; Assist in the creation of projects, implementation plans, and program goals.; Facilitate sharing sessions where health information data can be shared and well received.; Continuation and improvement of the development of Community Health programs/projects; Assist with overseeing the development of guidelines, procedures, and local policies.
