Under the general supervision of the Medical Director for the Center for Public Health Policy and Practice and the Director for Health Disparities and Public Health Policy, the fellow will conduct research and analysis of program evaluation and epidemiologic data associated with medical, clinical, and public health work. The fellow will support and develop public health initiatives and assist with epidemiologic and program evaluation studies, including design, implementation, analysis, and dissemination. The fellow will support and advance initiatives improving population health in Texas, particularly among vulnerable populations. Under the guidance of the director and other senior center staff the fellow will initiate and conduct analyses and reporting on data associated with health disparities and public health policy from focus group discussions and quantitative community-level data as well as examining surveillance efforts, epidemiologic trends, academic research, trends in service utilization and expenditures, and public health follow-up and care linkage efforts. The position may work with staff within the center and across the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to characterize medical, clinical, and public health efforts. Overnight travel to support DSHS staff at community events and with data collection activities in selected counties across the state may be required.

This position will contribute to public health profiles and reports for lay and professional audiences, and will contribute to grant development processes, including epidemiologic profiling, evaluation, formulating and measuring objectives, and data analysis. They will work under limited supervision with latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.
