Mission/Primary Goals of division, program or office-The Tuberculosis program prevents the spread of tuberculosis in Public Health Region 8.

Fellow projects, responsibilities, activities, and/or deliverables: The Fellow will perform highly advanced and comprehensive TB nursing services in Public Health Region 8 (PHR 8). In collaboration with the TB Nurse Consultant, develop treatment plans for TB cases, suspects, and individuals with TB infection. Perform nursing assessments to determine if a patient has TB. Provide case management of TB cases and suspects. Provide directly observed therapy (DOT) and directly observed preventive therapy (DOPT) to cases, suspects, and TBI cases. Help ensure timely contact investigation completion for each case and suspect. Contacts newly assigned patients and communicates written medication/treatment plan. Collects blood specimens as authorized through standing delegation orders of a DSHS physician, packages and ships the specimens, and documents collection. Monitors and improves clinical management services through the development of protocols and procedures. Completes investigations of disease reports, and consults with physicians, laboratories, hospital personnel, and members of the public. Tracks, evaluates, recommends, and develops programmatic procedures for improved quality assurance, program delivery, security, and confidentiality of data/data systems/processes for the region. Develops educational materials and implements training and education in TB and other communicable disease prevention, control, investigation, infection control, and reporting for health professionals, workplaces, and the general public. May provide guidance to other team members. Reports to the Communicable Disease Program Manager; with minimal supervision and can manage multiple, and complicated responsibilities independently. Up to 60% travel with the majority being day travel and approximately 30% travel may be overnight.
